Sir,

With due respect, I SI Dipanjan Bhadra of Bagdogra P.S., SPC hereby lodge a complaint against the following arrested accused persons namely i) Bapi Sen 34yrs s/o Sanjit Kr Sen of Rabindranagar PS, Bagdogra Dist. Darjeeling ii) Md Hamidul 38yrs s/o Md Mayarudin of Vestyjote PS, Bagdogra Dist. Darjeeling iii) Daud Kungari 42yrs s/o Late Haren Kungari of Sannashi Line-15 iv) Jyotish Lakra 32 yrs s/o Lt. Helariush Lakra of Traipoo TE 11 No line PS, Bagdogra Dist. Darjeeling v) Md Juned 18yrs s/o Md Jamir of Totaramjote PS, Naxabari for disobeying order of wearing of facial mask vide Memo no 486/CS/2021 dated 24.04.2021.

The facts of the case in brief is that today on 25/04/2021 at about 14.35 hrs in course of my special Mobile duty vide Bagdogra PS GDE No. 1872 Dated 25/04/2021 the above noted arrested persons were found that roaming at Panighata More, Bagdogra without wearing face mask as the Government of West Bengal has issued order vide Memo no 486/CS/2021 dated 24.04.2021 that wearing of facial mask made mandatory in public places in the current pandemic disaster situation that since the COVID-19 pandemic crisis is grave, all persons are to strictly comply with the COVID-19 safety norms of wearing face mask and maintaining social distance whenever they go out in public place. Accordingly, I stop them and ask their reason for not wearing mask but they could not give any satisfactory reason. It is pertinent to note here that since the outbreak of Second wave of Corona Virus awareness regarding wearing of face mask and social distancing had been conducted through miking but the above persons had no botheration regarding their own safety and also the safety of others. Their such act is dangerous so as to the spread of Corona Virus. Thereafter, I tried to convince them and directed them to wear face mask and maintained social distance but they denied to do so and started arguing with me. Finding no other alternative way I apprehended them to avoid risks to human life and health.

Under the above facts and circumstances, I request you that a specific case against the aforementioned persons may kindly started with suitable sections of law.
