With due respect, I SI Dipanjan Bhadra of Bagdogra P.S, SPC hereby lodge a complaint against the following arrested accused persons namely i) Tarun Ghosh 48yrs s/o Late Dulal Ch Ghosh of Khudirampolly PS, Bagdogra Dist. Darjeeling ii) Shyamal Paul 45yrs s/o Pulin Paul of Sri Colony iii) Indragish Gupta 33yrs s/o Sri Rajendra Nath Gupta of Harekrishna polly PS, Bagdogra Dist. Darjeeling iv) Sunil Singh 50yrs s/o Gayarakhia Singh of Naxalbari Bazar PS, Naxalbari Dist. Darjeeling v) Samir Sheikh 27yrs s/o Badru Sheikh of Naxalbari Baisahati PS, Naxalbari Dist. Darjeeling vi) Ratan Chowdhury 38yrs s/o Suresh Chowdhury of Drifish Market Matigara PS, Matigara vii) Ramesh Prasad 45yrs s/o Gaya Prasad of Rabindra Nagar PS, Bagdogra Dist. Darjeeling for disobeying order of wearing of facial mask vide Memo no 486/CS/2021 dated 24.04.2021

The facts of the case in brief is that today on 25/04/2021 at about 14.35 hrs in course of my special Mobile duty vide Bagdogra PS GDE No. 1872 Dated 25/04/2021 the above noted arrested persons were found that roaming at Bihar More, Bagdogra without wearing face mask as the Government of West Bengal has issued order vide Memo no 486/CS/2021 dated 24.04.2021 that wearing of facial mask made mandatory in public places in the current pandemic disaster situation that since the COVID-19 pandemic crisis is grave, all persons are to strictly comply with the COVID-19 safety norms of wearing face mask and maintaining social distance whenever they go out in public place. Accordingly, I stop them and ask their reason for not wearing mask but they could not give any satisfactory reason. It is pertinent to note here that since the outbreak of Second wave of Corona Virus awareness regarding wearing of face mask and social distancing had been conducted through milking but the above persons had no botheration regarding their own safety and also the safety of others. Their such act is dangerous so as to the spread of Corona Virus. Thereafter, I tried to convince them and directed them to wear face mask and maintained social distance but they denied to do so and started arguing with me. Finding no other alternative way, I apprehended them to avoid risks to human life and health.

Under the above facts and circumstances, I request you that a specific case against the aforementioned persons may kindly started with suitable sections of law.
