C.C.C and S&LP team of Jalpaiguri Regional Office, WBSEDCL (Sri Uttam Saha, DE(E) and Sri Partha Sarathi Majumder, Special Officer and staff conducted inspection on this premise and the malfunction found as described in tabular format:-
