I, SI Md. Ziaul Hoque of Bhaktinagar PS, SPC do hereby lodge complaint against the above noted accused persons, to the effect that 05.05.2021 at about 11.30 hrs while I along with officer and force were performing patrolling duty in c/w COVID-19 at Salugara Bazar area, under Bhaktinagar, PS, Dist-Jalpaiguri vide Bhaktinagar-PS GDE No 201 dated 05.05.2021. At about 12.05 hrs and during my patrolling duty found the above noted persons were moving without any mask and without any reason. Thereby making unnecessary gathering at Salugara Bazar area under Bhaktinagar, PS, Dist-Jalpaiguri. On being asked the above noted persons stated that they were well aware of pandemic Covid-19 situation and they supposed to wear face mask. Further I requested them to wear Mask and maintain the social distance but they did not pay any heed. Hence they all violated the order of Govt. of India duly promulgated in order no 40-3/2020-DM-I (A), Govt. of India Ministry of Home Affairs Dated 24.03.2020. They all also violated the order of Govt. of India duly promulgated in order no 40-3/2020-DM-I (A), Govt. of India Ministry of Home Affairs Dated 24.03.2020 and MHA (Internal Security Division) vide no-11034/01/02022-IS-IV Dt. 27/04/20 & Govt. of WB order No - 79-CS/2020 Dated- 12.04.2020 and advisory issued vide no- 715-Home 9Cons)/RIM (Cons)-92/2021 Dated- 17.04.2021 and Memo No- 486-CS/2021 Dated- 24.04.2021. and Order No 618-ISS/2M-22/2020 dated 30.04.2021. The above noted persons have intentionally refused to comply with the order of Govt. of India and Govt. of West Bengal duly promulgated in view of break- out of Pandemic COVID- 19 throughout the Country. Finding no any other alternative I arrested them under proper memo of arrest after explaining the charge against them.

Under the above circumstance I request you that a specific case may kindly be started U/S 188/269/270 IPC R/W Sec 51(b) Disaster Management Act. 2005 against the above noted 12(Twelve) arrested accused persons and arranged proper investigation of the case.
