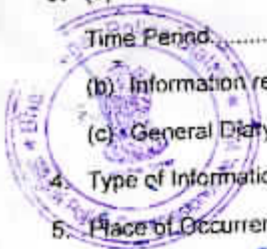

In producing herewith 04 (Four) arrested accused persons who disclosed their identity as (1) Bapi Biswas (40) s/o Late Nanigopal Biswas of Champasari, Ganesh Ghosh Colony, W/No. 46, PS Pradhan Nagar, Dist: Darjeeling. (2) Birendranath Barman (54) s/o Lt. Rajkumar Barman of Bhupendra Nagar, W/No. 42, PS Bhaktinagar, Dist: Jalpaiguri. (3) Nitanya Roy (28) s/o Subal Roy of Kholachand Fapri, P.O salugara, P.S Bhaktinagar, Dist Jalpaiguri.. (4) Rajesh Karjee (45) s/o Karnasingh Karjee of Vivekananda Nagar, W/No. 42, P.S Bhaktinagar, Dist. Jalpaiguri .

I, SI. D.N Bakshi of Bhaktinagar PS, SPC do hereby lodge complaint against the above noted persons, to the effect that 14.05.2021 while I along with officer and force were performing patrolling duty in c/w COVID-19 at 2nd Mile, Check Post, under Bhaktinagar, PS, Dist-Jalpaiguri vide Bhaktinagar PS GDE No 664 dated 14.05.2021. At around 11.15hrs to 13.00 hrs during my patrolling duty found the above noted persons were moving without any mask and without any reason. Thereby making unnecessary gathering at 2nd Mile, Check Post, under Bhaktinagar, PS, Dist-Jalpaiguri. On being asked the above noted persons stated that they were well aware of pandemic Covid-19 situation and they supposed to wear face mask. Further I requested them to wear Mask and maintain the social distance but they did not pay any heed. Hence they all violated the order of Govt. of India duly promulgated in order no 40-3/2020-DM-1 (A), Govt. of India Ministry of Home Affairs Dated 24.03.2020. They all also violated the order of Govt. of India duly promulgated in order no 40-3/2020-DM-1 (A), Govt. of India Ministry of Home Affairs Dated 24.03.2020 and MHA (Internal Security Division) vide no- 11034/01/02022-IS-IV Dt. 27/04/20 & Govt. of WB order No - 79-CS/2020 Dated- 12.04.2020 and advisory issued vide no- 715-Home 9Cons)/RIM (Cons)-92/2021 Dated- 17.04.2021 and Memo No- 486-CS/2021 Dated- 24.04.2021. The above noted persons have intentionally refused to comply with the order of Govt. of India and Govt. of West Bengal duly promulgated in view of break- out of Pandemic COVID- 19 throughout the Country. Finding no any other alternative I arrested them under proper memo of arrest after explaining the charge against them.

Under the above circumstance I request you that a specific case may kindly be started U/S 188/269/270 IPC R/W Sec 51(b) Disaster Management Act. 2005 against the above noted 04(four) arrested accused persons and arranged proper investigation of the case.
