Sir,


With due respect, I SI Bhabatosh Sarkar of Bagdogra P.S, SPC do hereby lodge a complaint against the following person namely Ranjan Kumar 19yrs s/o Gopi Roy of Kesopur PO, Balukaram PS+ Dist. Baishali Bihar for disobeying order of social distance vide Memo no 486/CS/2021 dated 24.04.2021.


The facts of the case in brief is that today on 14/05/2021 at about 19.05 hrs in course of my evening QRT Mobile duty vide Bagdogra PS GDE No. 583 Dated 14/05/2021 and found that the above noted person was roaming at Kestopur more to not wear face mask norms as the Government of West Bengal has issued order vide Memo no 486/CS/2021 dated 24.04.2021 that wearing of facial mask and social distance made mandatory in public places in the current pandemic disaster situation that since the COVID-19 pandemic crisis is grave, all persons are to strictly comply with the COVID-19 safety norms of wearing face mask they go out in public place. Accordingly, I stop him and ask his reason for not wear face mask but he could not give any satisfactory reason also violate against us. It is pertinent to note here that since the outbreak of Second wave of Corona Virus awareness regarding wearing of face mask and social distancing had been conducted through miking but the above noted person had no botheration regarding his own safety and also the safety of others. Their act is dangerous so as to the spread of Corona Virus. Thereafter, I tried to convince him and directed him to wear face mask but he denied to do so and started arguing with me. Finding no other alternative way, I apprehended him to avoid risks to human life and health.

Under the above facts and circumstances, I request you that a specific case against the aforementioned person may kindly started with suitable sections of law.
