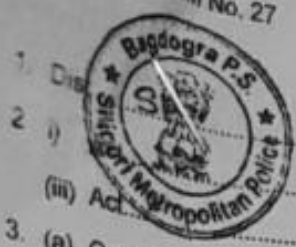

Sir,

With due respect, I SI Dipanjan Bhadra of Bagdogra P.S, SPC do hereby lodge a complaint against the following persons namely i) Md Azimuuddin 35yrs s/o Md Saifuddin of Sihiya Jote Bimabari PS, Kharibari Dist, Darjeeling ii) Md Dabir 40yrs s/o Late Md Jamiruddin of Debiganj PS, Kharibari Dist, Darjeeling iii) Md Sahid 28yrs s/o Md Jakir Hussain 28yrs of Singiya Jote PS, Kharibari Dist, Darjeeling iv) Sanjay Gupta 40yrs s/o Mirakhan Gupta of Balam Nagar PS, Bagdogra Dist, Darjeeling v) Sanju Singh 26yrs s/o Umesh Singh of Palpara PS, Matigara Dist, Darjeeling vi) Lalit Roy 32yrs s/o Ombi Roy of Baukali Jote Tarbandha PS, Bagdogra Dist, Darjeeling vii) Abishek Baraik 21yrs s/o Rajen Baraik of Lichubagan PS, Bagdogra Dist, Darjeeling viii) Naren Ghosh 40yrs s/o Badal Ghosh of Ganesh Bhosh Colony Champasari PS, Pradhannagar Dist, Darjeeling for disobeying Government order vide Memo no 486/CS/2021 dated 24.04.2021 and order No 647-ISS/2M-22/2020 dated 15.05.2021.

The facts of the case in brief is that today on 16/05/2021 at about 10.40 hrs in course of Morning Mobile duty vide Bagdogra PS GDE No. 653 Dated 16/05/2021 found that the above noted persons was roaming at Bihar More area do not wear face mask norms as the Government of West Bengal has issued various order vide Memo no 486/CS/2021 dated 24.04.2021 that wearing of facial mask and social distance made mandatory in public places in the current pandemic disaster situation that since the COVID-19 pandemic crisis is grave, all persons are to strictly comply with the COVID-19 safety norms of wearing face mask while they go out in public place. On 15.05.2021 Government of West Bengal further issued order that complete lockdown from in effect from 6 AM Sunday 16<sup>th</sup> shall remain May to 6 PM 30<sup>th</sup> May 2021 vide order No 647-ISS/2M-22/2020 dated 15.05.2021 in terms of the provisions under Disaster Management Act 2005 read with West Bengal Epidemic Disease, Covid-19 Regulations 2020 unnecessary movement shall be strictly prohibited. Accordingly, I stop them and ask to reason for not wear of face mask and roaming unnecessary but they could not give any satisfactory reason also violate against us. It is pertinent to note here that since the outbreak of Second wave of Corona Virus awareness regarding wearing of face mask and maintain of social distancing had been conducted through miking but the above noted persons had no botheration regarding their own safety and also the safety of others. Their act is dangerous so as to the spread of Corona Virus. Thereafter, I tried to convince them and directed to wear face mask but they denied to do so and started arguing with me. Finding no other alternative way, I apprehended them to avoid risks to human life and health.

Under the above facts and circumstances, I request you that a specific case against the aforementioned persons may kindly started with suitable sections of law.
