Sir,

In producing herewith the arrested accused persons namely 1. Binod Barman(25) S/O Baisak Barman of Balasan Colony, PS. Matigara, Dist. Darjeeling 2. Biplab Sarkar (21) S/O Lt Madan Sarkar of Kawakhali, Bidhanpally, PS. Matigara, Dist. Darjeeling. 3. Avijit Roy(25) S/O Lt Gopal Roy of Purba Ayudha Nagar, Salkumar Hat, PS. Alipurduar, Dist. Alipurduar 4. Mazibul Haque(30) S/O Basiruddin of Budhugach, P.O. Nakugach, PS. Rajganj, Dist. Jalpaiguri 5. Taribul Haque(25) S/O Sukruddin of Do arrested u/s 41 Cr.PC do hereby lodge a written complaint against them.

In this regard, I beg to state that on 16/05/2021 at about 18.05 hrs while performing special mobile duty vide GDE No. 442 DT: 16/05/2021, received information that some people are violating the order of Lockdown and roaming at aimlessly at Chathat Medical More area. Informed O/C, Matigara PS and as per his direction, I along with force and had been to Chathat Medical More under NBMC OP, on seeing police, they tried to flee away but somehow, the above noted persons could be apprehended. and arrested the above noted four persons. Thereby completely violating the lockdown measures issued by Chief Secretary West Bengal vide order no. 618-ISS/2M-22/2020 DTD.30/04/2021 and 622-ISS/2M-22/2020 DTD. 1<sup>st</sup> May 2021 issued by the Ministry of Health & family Welfare, Government of India Order no. 403/2020-DM-1(A) Dtd.29/04/2021 and Order No.647-ISS/2M-22/2020 DTD.15/05/2021. On interrogation, they disclosed their name and address as noted above. On further interrogation, they admitted that they were aware of the lockdown Order and Restrictions imposed upon the movement of human being and shops. As they has violated the Lockdown Order promulgate by the appropriate Government Authority and also the provision of Disaster Management Act, 2005, I with the help of force arrested them U/S 41 CrPC by issuing them memo of arrest.

I, therefore pray that a specific case under proper section of law may kindly be initiated against the above noted arrested accused persons.
