Sub: Complaint against disobeying order of Lock down and social distance

Sir,

With due respect, I SI Mijanur Rahaman of Bagdogra P.S, 3PC hereby lodge a complaint against the following persons namely (1) MD Asraf Ali (21 Yrs) S/O MD. Aurangzeb Ali of Khudiram pally P.S Bagdogra Dist Darjeeling (2) MD Asif Ali (22 yrs) S/O MD Aurangzeb Ali of Khudiram pally P.S Bagdogra Dist Darjeeling (3) MD Rafique Sha (30yrs) S/O Lt. MD Tayyab Sha of Khudiram pally P.S Bagdogra Dist Darjeeling (4) Rahul Thakur (26 yrs) of Panighatta More P.S Bagdogra Dist Darjeeling (5) Suraj Mallick (21 yrs) S/O Binod Mallick of Ho-Chi-Min Nagar P.S Bagdogra Dist Darjeeling for disobeying order of Lock down and social distance.

The facts of the case in brief are that today on 20/05/2021 at about 16.05 hrs I along with force in course of QRT 36 Mobile duty at Bihar More vide Bagdogra PS GDE No. 917 Dated 20/05/2021 was found that the above noted person was roaming at Bihar More without mask as well as without any reason. Accordingly I stop them and ask their reason for roaming at Bihar More area as the government announces Lock down to save people from the spread of compassion disease of COVID 19 but they could not give any satisfactory reason for their roaming. Thereafter I tried to convince them and directed them to maintained social distance and not to go out from home unnecessarily. But they denied to so and started arguing with me. Finding no other alternative way I apprehended them to avoid risks to human life and health as they violating the provisions of Government rules as convey by the health ministry in the pretext of COVID-19 spreading in India.

Under the above facts and circumstances, I request you that a specific case against the aforementioned person may kindly started with suitable sections of law.
