Sir,

In producing herewith 02 (Two) arrested accused person who disclosed their identity as 1) Raj Kumar Barman (55) S/O Kekar Barman of Sahid Colony Ps. NJP Dist Jalpaiguri 2) Mukulesh Das (19) S/O Bijoy Das of Gate Bazar Ps. NJP Dist. Jalpaiguri along with two seized TOTO as follows

- 1) One Green Colour TOTO Having No WB73E/ 3503.
- 2) One Red Colour TOTO.

I, SI Jimut Kanti Roy Roy of New Jalpaiguri Traffic Guard, SPC do here by lodge this written complaint against the above noted two persons to the effect that while on performing Naka duty at Netaji More for the purpose of Covid Lock Down found that the above noted two persons without wearing mask are plying their ToTo without any specific reason. Thereby they were making unnecessary gathering at Netaji More, New Jalpaiguri. On being asked the above noted persons stated before me that they were well aware of Govt. Order regarding pandemic situation of Covid-19 and wearing of facial mask is mandatory in public places in the current pandemic disaster situation.

Thus, they both violated the order of Govt. of West Bengal vide Memo No. 486-CS/2021 dt. 24.04.2021. Hence I seized the two ToTos from their possession duly signed by them and arrested them at once issuing memo of arrest informing the ground of arrest. The arrest and seizure were made on 21.05.21 in between 10.45 hrs to 11.05 hrs.

Therefore you are hereby requested for starting a specific case U/S 188/269/270 IPC r/w sec 51 (b) of Disaster Management Act.2005 against the above noted two accused persons and arrange proper investigation of the case.
