Sub: Complaint against disobeying order of Lock down and social distance

Sir,

With due respect, I SI Laksang Bhutia of Bagdogra P.S, SPC, hereby lodge a complaint against the following persons namely (1) Ashok Tamang (35 years) S/O Phurba Tamnag of Bhutta Bari, PS. Bagdogra, Dist. Darjeeling (2) Sudipta Halder (35 years) S/O Sudhir Halder of Airport More PS. Bagdogra Dist. Darjeeling (3) Binod Kumar Ram (18 years) S/O Late Ramanand Ram of Harekrishna Pally PS. Bagdogra Dist Darjeeling (4) Rahul Gupta (18 years) S/O Subh Narayan Gupta of Harekrishna Pally PS. Bagdogra Dist Darjeeling, (5) Arjun Singh(41 Years), S/o Radheshyam Singh of Kestopur Chowpukuria, P.S Bagdogra , Dist Darjeeling, (6) Ram Krishna Barman (42 Years) S/o Late Jagdhu Ram Barman of Kestopur Chowpukuria, P.S Bagdogra , Dist Darjeeling, for disobeying order of Lock down and social distance.

The facts of the case in brief are that today on 30/05/2021 at evening I along with force in course of NAKA Checking duty at Bihar More vides Bagdogra PS GDE No.1390 Dated 30/05/2021 was found that the above noted persons were going towards Siliguri. Accordingly I stop them and ask their reason for their movement as the government announces Lock down to save people from the spread of compassion disease of COVID 19 but they could not give any satisfactory reason for their movement. Thereafter I tried to convince them and directed them to maintained social distance and not to go out from home unnecessarily. But they denied to so and started arguing with me. Finding no other alternative way I apprehended them to avoid risks to human life and health as they violating the provisions of Government rules as convey by the health ministry in the pretext of COVID-19 spreading in India.

Under the above facts and circumstances, I request you that a specific case against the aforementioned person may kindly started with suitable sections of law.
