Sub: Complaint against disobeying order of Lock down and social distance
Sir,

With due respect, I SI Kartick Sarkar of Bagdogra P.S, SPC hereby lodge a complaint against the following persons namely (1) Krishna Das (40years) S/O Molin Chandra Das of Sree Colony, PS. Bagdogra, Dist-Darjeeling, (2) Md. Ajmer Ansari (33 years) S/O Md. Islam Ansari of Panchkalguri, Nemaï, PS. Nemaï, Dist-Darjeeling (3) Samiran Paul (25 years) S/O Ramani Paul of Pal Para, P.S.Matigara, Dist- Darjeeling, (4) Bijay Das (23 Years) S/o Laxman Das, of Narayan Pally, Shivmandir, PS. Matigara, Darjeeling, (5) Prabir Mukherjee (49 Years), S/o Late Bhabotosh Mukherjee of Sree Colony, P.S. Bagdogra, Dist- Darjeeling, (6) Manoj Roy (42years) S/o Biren Roy of Maszid Para, P.S Bagdogra, Dist- Darjeeling disobeying order of Lock down and social distance.

The facts of the case in brief are that today on 05/06/2021 at evening I along with force in course of QRT 36 Mobile duty at Bihar More vides Bagdogra PS GDE No. 231 at 12:15hrs Dated 05/06/2021 was found that the above noted person was roaming at Bihar More without mask as well as without any reason. Accordingly I stop them and ask their reason for roaming at Bihar More area as the government announces Lock down to save people from the spread of compassion disease of COVID 19 but they could not give any satisfactory reason for their roaming. Thereafter I tried to convince them and directed them to maintained social distance and not to go out from home unnecessarily. But they denied to so and started arguing with me. Finding no other alternative way I apprehended them to avoid risks to human life and health as they violating the provisions of Government rules as convey by the health ministry in the pretext of COVID-19 spreading in India.

Under the above facts and circumstances, I request you that a specific case against the aforementioned person may kindly started with suitable sections of law.
