Sir,

With due respect, I SI Dipankar Chakraborty of Bagdogra PS, do hereby lodge this written complaint against the following arrested persons namely i) Kerobin Kerketta 29yrs s/o Late Pitter Kerketta of New Chamta Tea Estate PS-Matigara Dist-Darjeeling ii) Sablu Munda 28yrs s/o Late Chatu Singh Munda of New Chamta Tea Estate PS-Matigara Dist-Darjeeling iii) Avirat Chakraborty 26yrs s/o Bhopen Chakraborty of Indrapolly of PS-Matigara Dist-Darjeeling iv) Sanjib Rai 32yrs s/o Late Pranchish Rai of Bidhanpolly Shibmandir PS-Matigara Dist-Darjeeling v) Premananda Singha 44yrs s/o Chamaru Singha of Boukalijote PS, Bagdogra Dist, Darjeeling vi) Md Lalu 49yrs s/o Md Anwar of Chakarmari PS, Kharibari Dist, Darjeeling for disobeying Government order vide Memo no 486/CS/2021 dated 24.04.2021 and order No 647-155/2M-22/2020 dated 15.05.2021.


The facts of the case in brief is that today on 06/06/2021 at about 16.55 hrs in course of special Naka checking duty vide Bagdogra PS GDE No 233 Dated 06/06/2021 found that the above noted person were approaching towards **Panighata more** from Naxalbari side they all do not wear face mask norms as the Government of West Bengal has issued various order vide Memo no 486/CS/2021 dated 24.04.2021 that wearing of facial mask and maintain social distance made mandatory in public places in the current pandemic disaster situation that since the COVID-19 pandemic crisis is grave, all persons are to strictly comply with the COVID-19 safety norms in effect from 6 AM Sunday 16<sup>th</sup> May to shall remain 6 PM 15<sup>th</sup> June 2021 vide order No 647-155/2M-22/2020 dated 15.05.2021 in terms of the provisions under Disaster Management Act 2005 read with West Bengal Epidemic Disease, Covid-19 Regulations 2020 unnecessary movement shall be strictly prohibited. Accordingly, I stop them and ask to reason for not wear of face mask and roaming unnecessary but they could not give any satisfactory reason also violate against our police party. It is pertinent to note here that since the outbreak of Second wave of Corona Virus awareness regarding wearing of face mask and maintain of social distancing had been conducted through mixing but the above noted persons had no botheration regarding their own safety and also the safety of others. Their act is dangerous so as to the spread of Corona Virus. Thereafter, I tried to convince them and directed to wear face mask but they denied to do so and started arguing with me. Finding no other alternative way, I apprehended them to avoid risks to human life and health.

Under the above facts and circumstances, I request you that a specific case against the aforementioned persons may kindly started with suitable sections of law.
