In producing herewith 06 (six) arrested accused persons who disclosed their identity as (i) Sahanur Alam (20 yrs), s/o - Jainuddin Alam of Jayerkama, PS- Kotwali, Dist- Jalpaiguri (ii) Rabi Mandal (26 yrs), s/o - Sunil Mandal of -Do- (iii) Md. Hasinul (21 yrs), s/o - Nasirul Haque of Boro Chowdhury Para, Paharpur, PS- Kotwali, Dist - Jalpaiguri (iv) Nur Hossain (20 yrs), s/o - Abdul Mazi of -Do- (v) Ramen Roy (37 yrs), s/o - Akul Roy of Anandapur, PS- Malbazar, Dist - Jalpaiguri (vi) Subrata Das (43 yrs), s/o - Swapan Kr. Das of 1 No Takimari, PO- Milanpally, PS- NJP, Dist Jalpaiguri.

I, ASI Sanjoy Saha of Milanpally OP under NJP PS /SPC do here by lodge this written complaint against the above noted persons to the effect that while on performing spl. mobile Van duty myself along with officer and forces had been to Teesta Barrage under Milanpally OP at 11:35 hrs and found that the above noted persons are gathered there without any reason and found them without wearing mask. Thereby making unnecessary gathering at Teesta Barrage under Milanpally OP. On being asked the above noted persons stated before me that they were well aware of Lock Down situation and they suppose to remain at their respective house. On being asked they stated that they were well aware of The Govt Order regarding pandemic situation of COVID 19 and wearing of facial mask has been mandatory in public places in the current pandemic disaster situation.

They all violated the order of Govt. of West Bengal vide Memo No - 486-CS/2021, Dated - 24/04/2021 & Govt Order No - 647-ISS/2M-22/2021, Dated - 15.05.21. Hence I arrested them u/s - 41 Cr.P.C in c/w the case under proper memo of arrest duly signed by them in presence of witnesses.

Now I request you for starting a specific case U/S-188/269/270 IPC r/w Sec 51(b) of Disaster Management Act 2005 against the above noted accused persons and arrange proper investigation of the case.
