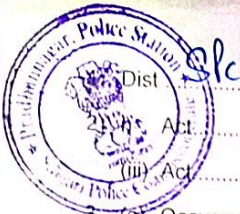

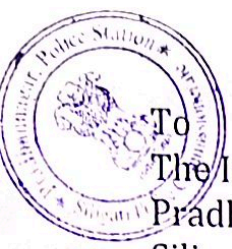

Sir,

In producing here with three arrested accused persons namely 1) Krishan Dey (31) s/o Ratan Dey of State Guest House, Netaji Nagar, Champasari, PS Pradhannagar, Dist Darjeeling, 2) Rohit Malakar (31) s/o Lt. Sri Ganesh Malakar of G 1331 C.R Park New Delhi, PS- C.R Park Dist- South Delhi, 3) Sandeep Mech (24) S/o Gouri Kanta Mech of methibari, Near SBI Bank, PO- Sukna PS-Pradhannagar, Dist- Darjeeling arrested U/S 41 Cr.P.C and do hereby lodge a written complaint against them.

In this regard I beg to complain that on 14.06.2021 while performing K31-II van I found that the above noted person was gathering and loitering without wearing mask at Darjeeling More under Pradhan nagar P.S. As they violated the order No.-647-ISS/2M-22/2020 dated 15/05/2021 and Notification number 347 -01.S.S / 2M-24/2020 dated 3rd June, 2020 and Memo No 486-CS/2021 dated 24th April, 2021 Promulgated by Govt. of West Bengal to combat with the spread of Covid-19.

I along with force apprehended them finding no other alternative and I arrest them U/S 41C.rPC. On interrogation, they disclosed their names and address as noted above. On further grilling, they admitted that they were aware of the Lockdown Order and restrictions imposed upon the movement of general public and vehicle to combat against the spread of Covid-19.

I, therefore, pray before you that a specific case may kindly be started against above noted arrested accused persons and take lawful action.
