Civil Judge Junior Division at Jalpaiguri being T.S No. 236/2017 through their power of attorney holder Sri Ranjit Gharami, S/o. Satyaranjan Gharami, resident of Hatidanga, P.O. - Sahudangi Hat, P.S.- Bhaktinagar, Dist. Jalpaiguri, against me and Sri Subrata Sarkar, of Hatidanga Bazar, P.O. Sahudangi Hat, P.S. - Bhaktinagar, Dist. Jalpaiguri, Sri Nitu Jai, S/o. Late Jagdish Jai, and Smt. Siyu Kumari Yadav, W/o. Court was pleased to pass an exparte interim injunction of 'Status-Quo' on 14.11.2017.

I would like to further inform you that thereafter I came to know that said Sri Sudip Roy and Smt. Bangrishwari Roy through their constituted attorney Sri Ranjit Gharami have transferred the said land which is the subject matter of the suit in favour of Sri Sanjib Gharami, S/o. Satyaranjan Gharami (i.e. the brother of the Ranjit Gharami), and Smt. Chaina sarkar (Majumder), W/o. Sri Subrata Sarkar At present residing at Hatidanga Bazar, P.O. Sahudangi Hat, P.S. - Bhaktinagar, Dist. Jalpaiguri, and aforesaid Sri Nitu Jai by virtue of a registered deed of sale being instrument no. 6786 for the year of 2017 and same was registered on 30.11.2017 before Additional District Sub-Registrar, Bhaktinagar, Dist. Jalpaiguri by violating and suppressing of the order of the Ld. Court.


