Respected Sir,

I, Uttam Thapa, S/o. Budhe Thapa, R/o. Lalit Nagar, Lower Bagdogra, P.O. & P.S. Bagdogra, District Darjeeling, Pin-734014, West Bengal, would like to state that on 17.06.2021 at about 5.00 P.M. when I was standing at Bihar More one person namely Rakesh Das, son of Not known residence of Natun Para, behind Charak Maath, P.O. & P.S. Bagdogra, District Darjeeling, Pin-734014, West Bengal without any provocation, intentionally started using slang language at me. On my query Rakesh Das physically assaulted me with hits and blow. Due to his assault I fell down and sustained head injury. When I felt down he sat on my chest and continuously assaulted me. On my hue and cry my wife Smt. Puja Thapa & some other peoples nearby came and saved me from his cruel hands. Rakesh Das snatched money amounting to Rs.4500/- (Rupees Four Thousand and Five Hundred only) which was in my trouser pocket and also threatened me that if I lodge any case against him then he will again physically assault me wherever he will see me. I have no other option left so I came before you. Rakesh Das is a drive and he owns a commercial Car bearing being No. WB 73 E 5014. As soon as he saw local public he fled with his car from the spot.

It is requested before you in folded hand to kindly take strict necessary action against Rakesh Das.
