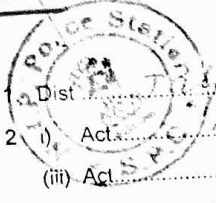

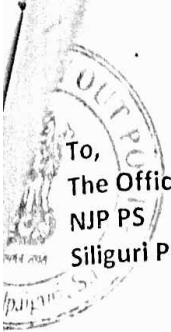

Sir,

In producing herewith 04 (four) arrested accused persons who disclosed their identity as (i) Mintu Roy (32 yrs), s/o – Bhabani Kanta Roy of Chewlibari, PO- Kundardighi, PS- Rajganj, Dist – Jalpaiguri (ii) Chandan Royt (24 yrs), s/o – Dharendra Nath Roy of Gouridangi, PO- Fatapukur, PS- Rajganj, Dist – Jalpaiguri (iii) Samir Saha (20 yrs), s/o – Ram Saha of Ghorarbari, PO- Sahudangi, PS- NJP, Dist – Jalpaiguri (iv) Rajat Dey Sarkar (21 yrs), S/O – Sambhu Dey Sarkar of Business Colony, PO- Kamarvita, PS- NJP, Dist – Jalpaiguri.

I, ASI Biswajit Adhikari of Milanpally OP under NJP PS /SPC do here by lodge this written complaint against the above noted persons to the effect that while on performing spl. mobile Van duty myself along with officer and forces had been to Gatebazar under Milanpally OP at 11:05 hrs and found that the above noted persons are gathered there without any reason and found them without wearing mask. Thereby making unnecessary gathering at Gatebazar under Milanpally OP. On being asked the above noted persons stated before me that they were well aware of Lock Down situation and they suppose to remain at their respective house. On being asked they stated that they were well aware of The Govt Order regarding pandemic situation of Covid 19 and wearing of facial mask has been mandatory in public places in the current pandemic disaster situation.

They all*violated the order of Govt. of West Bengal vide Memo No – 486-CS/2021, Dated – 24/04/2021 & Govt Order No – 647-ISS/2M-22/2021, Dated – 15.05.21. Hence I arrested them u/s – 41 Cr.P.C in c/w the case under proper memo of arrest duly signed by them in presence of witnesses.

Now I request you for starting a specific case U/S-188/269/270 IPC r/w Sec 51(b) of Disaster Management Act 2005 against the above noted accused persons and arrange proper investigation of the case.
