Sir,

With due respect and in producing herewith the arrested accused person namely Parimal Sarkar (52) S/o Lt. Manoranjan Sarkar of Surya Sen Colony, PO- Bhaktinagar, PS- NJP, Dist.- Jalpaiguri and following seized articles viz:

- 1) 18 (Eighteen) bottles Of Himalayan Gold Premium 60 up Country Spirit each containing 300 ml in each pack, MRP Rs. 50/- each (Total value Rs.900 /-).
- 2) 22 (Twenty two) bottles Of Himalayan Gold Premium 60 up Country Spirit each containing 600 ml in each pack, MRP Rs. 100/- each (Total value Rs.2,200 /-).

I, SI Shib Sankar Das of NJP PS, Siliguri Police Commissionerate, do hereby lodge this complaint to the effect that on 18/06/2021 at about 17:10 hrs during special simultaneous drive, received a secret source information that one Parimal Sarkar (52) S/o Lt. Manoranjan Sarkar of Surya Sen Colony, PO- Bhaktinagar, PS- NJP, Dist.- Jalpaiguri is selling/stored huge quantity of ID liquor at his shop at Surya Sen Colony for his wrongful gain. Accordingly the matter was diarised vide NJP PS GDE No: 864 date:18.06.2021 and informed the fact to O/C, NJP PS, SPC and per his direction myself along with force C/1089 Bablu Das, C/1441 Shakti Padda Das, C/1438 Kamal Barman left for Surya Sen Colony to work out the information. At about 17:25 hrs being shown by the source myself along with the force had been to the Shop of Parimal Sarkar (52) S/o Lt. Manoranjan Sarkar of Surya Sen Colony, PO- Bhaktinagar, PS- NJP, Dist.- Jalpaiguri and found he is selling the illicit liquor illegally in shop and we detained him. On interrogation he disclosed his identity as noted above and after searching his shop, found total 40 (Forty) bottles of Himalayan Gold in different quantity inside of the shop. On demand he failed to produce any valid documents in respect of the seized articles. Accordingly, I seized all the above noted articles in between 17:40 hrs to 18.05 hrs, in presence of witnesses and also arrested the accused person namely Parimal Sarkar (52) S/o Lt. Manoranjan Sarkar of Surya Sen Colony, PO- Bhaktinagar, PS- NJP, Dist.- Jalpaiguri u/s 41 Cr.P.C after maintaining all the formalities.

Hence, it is evident that the accused person named Parimal Sarkar (52) S/o Lt. Manoranjan Sarkar of Surya Sen Colony, PO- Bhaktinagar, PS- NJP, Dist.- Jalpaiguri is involved in selling of illicit liquor illegally without any valid license for their wrongful gain.

Therefore, I request that a specific case may kindly be started against the accused person namely Parimal Sarkar (52) S/o Lt. Manoranjan Sarkar of Surya Sen Colony, PO- Bhaktinagar, PS- NJP, Dist.- Jalpaiguri under proper section of Law and arrange for its investigation.
