Sir,

In producing herewith one accused person namely Paritosh Roy (23) S/O Sri Nirbhay Roy of Bakuabari, P.o-Mahanbita, PS- NJP, Dist- Jalpaiguri along with the following seized articles as per proper seizure list:

(i) 35 (Thirty Five) bottles of Pet Galaxy Boss 60° UP Country Spirit 600 ml. each.

I, SI Phup Rinchey Bhutia of Ambari Falakata out post under NJP PS, SPC, lodged a written complaint against the above noted person to the effect that today i.e. on 19.06.2021 at 06.15 hrs received a source information that at the house of Paritosh Roy (23) S/O Sri Nirbhay Roy of Bakuabari, P.o-Mahanbita, PS- NJP, Dist- Jalpaiguri has gathered huge amount of liquor illegally for selling the same in the customer for his wrongful gain. This refers to Ambari Falakata out post GDE no-701 dated 19.06.21. I informed to O/C Ambari Falakata out post about the information. As per his kind instruction I along with, ASI Kajal Chakraborty, CVF/963 Tapan Roy, CVF/001 Jay Chand Roy, CVF/483 Khirmohan Roy proceed to Bakuabari to work out the information. At 06.45 hrs we reached at the spot, sometimes after being identified by the source our police party held raid at the house of Paritosh Roy and recovered the above noted articles from the possession of the above noted accused person namely Paritosh Roy (23) S/O Sri Nirbhay Roy of Bakuabari, P.o-Mahanbita, PS- NJP, Dist- Jalpaiguri . On demand he could not produce any valid license/documents in support of the said liquor. He become nervous and admitted his guilt before us and stated that he sell the same in the customer since long for his wrongful gain. In presence of witnesses namely 1) Subhas Sarkar S/o Lt Narayan Sarkar of Mahamaya colony PS-NJP Dist-JPG. 2) Rabi Thapa S/O Ramesh Thapa of Durgaguri, PS- Pradhanagar Dist-Darjeeling, I have seized the above noted articles from the possession of the above noted accused person after preparing proper seizure list and took signature of the accused person and witnesses. The seizure was made between 06.50 hrs to 07.20 hrs. Therefore, finding no other alternatives I have arrested the said accused person u/s 41 Cr.P.C. and issued Memo of arrest appraising the ground of arrest in presence of the witnesses.

Hence, I request you a specific case may kindly be started against the accused person namely Paritosh Roy (23) S/O Sri Nirbhay Roy of Bakuabari, P.o-Mahanbita, PS- NJP, Dist- Jalpaiguri under proper section of law.
