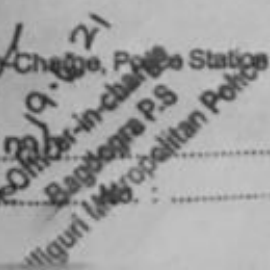


With due respect, I PSI Manzil Moktan of Bagdogra PS, do hereby lodge this written complaint against the following arrested persons namely i) Rakesh Subba 39yrs s/o Meg Bahadur Subba of Godadhar Polly PS, Bagdogra Dist, Darjeeling ii) Siril Lakra 55yrs s/o Isdor Lakra of Stalinnagar PS, Bagdogra Dist, Darjeeling iii) Surender Roy 28yrs s/o Bipad Roy of Bimannagar Bhujipani PS, Bagdogra Dist, Darjeeling iv) Avlshek Munda 18yrs s/o Etwamunda of Batashi TG Pulline PS, Kharibari Dist, Darjeeling v) Mujaffar Hussain 30yrs s/o Md Khalil of Ramajote Bhujipani PS, Bagdogra Dist, Darjeeling for disobeying Government order vide Memo no 486/CS/2021 dated 24.04.2021 and order No 647-ISS/2M-22/2020 dated 15.05.2021.


The facts of the case in brief is that today on 18/06/2021 at about 17.25 hrs in course of evening Naka duty vide Bagdogra PS GDE No 977 Dated 19/06/2021 the above noted persons were roaming unnecessary at **Bihar more, ti-junction** area all of them did not wear face mask as the Government of West Bengal has issued various order vide Memo no 486/CS/2021 dated 24.04.2021 that wearing of facial mask and maintain social distance made mandatory in public places in the current pandemic disaster situation all persons are to strictly comply with the COVID-19 safety norms in effect from 6 AM Sunday 16<sup>th</sup> May to shall remain 6 PM 15<sup>th</sup> June 2021 vide order No 647-ISS/2M-22/2020 dated 15.05.2021 in terms of the provisions under Disaster Management Act 2005 read with West Bengal Epidemic Disease, Covid-19 Regulations 2020 unnecessary movement shall be strictly prohibited. Accordingly, I stop them and ask to reason for not wear of face mask and roaming unnecessary but they could not give any satisfactory reason also violate against our police party. It is pertinent to note here that since the outbreak of Second wave of Corona Virus awareness regarding wearing of face mask and maintain of social distancing had been conducted through miking but the above noted persons had no botheration regarding their own safety and also the safety of others. Their act is dangerous so as to the spread of Corona Virus. Thereafter, I tried to convince them and directed to wear face mask but they denied to do so and started arguing with me. Finding no other alternative way, I apprehended them to avoid risks to human life and health.

Under the above facts and circumstances, I request you that a specific case against the aforementioned persons may kindly started with suitable sections of law.
