
With due respect, I PSI Lawang Bomzon of Bagdogra PS, do hereby lodge this written complaint against the following arrested persons namely i) Ashok Sahani 21yrs s/o Shambhu Bhagat of Jyotinagar of Ho-Chi-Min Nagar PS, Bagdogra Dist, Darjeeling ii) Indrajit Kr Roy 40yrs s/o Jugal Roy of New MES Colony PS, Bagdogra Dist, Darjeeling iii) Zakir Hussain 30yrs s/o Rahamat Ali of Hare Krishna Polly PS, Bagdogra Dist, Darjeeling iv) Bhabatosh Barman 34yrs s/o Sarhidhan Barman of Maharaja PS, Raiganj Dist, Uttar Dinajpur A/P Kadamtala PS, Matigara Dist, Darjeeling v) Ananda Ch Roy 29yrs s/o Late Debandra Nath Roy of Uttar Gurudebpur PO, Dharampur PS, Maynaguri Dist, Darjeeling A/P Kadamtala PS, Matigara Dist, Darjeeling vi) Subash Yadav 65yrs s/o Late Nopti of Harekriishna Polly PS, Bagdogra Dist, Darjeeling vii) Bipul Das 44yrs s/o late Babulal Das of of Harekriishna Polly PS, Bagdogra Dist, Darjeeling for disobeying Government order vide Memo no 486/CS/2021 dated 24.04.2021 and order No 647-155/2M-22/2020 dated 15.05.2021.


The facts of the case in brief is that today on 03/07/2021 at about 06.15 hrs in course of Morning Naha duty vide Bagdogra PS GDE No 92 Dated 03/07/2021 the above noted persons were roaming unnecessary at **Bihar more, area 31 no vi and vii accused persons** handed over by the Army personnel they were moving their nearby prohibited area unnecessarily all of did not wear face mask as the Government of West Bengal has issued various order vide Memo no 486/CS/2021 dated 24.04.2021 that wearing of facial mask and maintain social distance made mandatory in public places in the current pandemic disaster situation all persons are to strictly comply with the COVID-19 safety norms in effect from 6 AM Sunday 16th May to shall remain 6 PM 15th June 2021 vide order No 647-155/2M-22/2020 dated 15.05.2021 in terms of the provisions under Disaster Management Act 2005 read with West Bengal Epidemic Disease, Covid-19 Regulations 2020 unnecessary movement shall be strictly prohibited. Accordingly, I stop them and ask to reason for not wear of face mask and roaming unnecessary but they could not give any satisfactory reason also violate against our police party. It is pertinent to note here that since the outbreak of Second wave of Corona Virus awareness regarding wearing of face mask and maintain of social distancing had been conducted through miking but the above noted persons had no botheration regarding their own safety and also the safety of others. Their act is dangerous so as to the spread of Corona Virus. Thereafter, I tried to convince them and directed to wear face mask but they denied to do so and started arguing with me. Finding no other alternative way, I apprehended them to avoid risks to human life and health.

Under the above facts and circumstances, I request you that a specific case against the aforementioned persons may kindly started with suitable sections of law.
