Sir,

In producing herewith the arrested accused persons namely (1) Dipak Barman (28) S/O- Lt Kanai Barman of Porajhar, Nayapur, P.S- NJP Dist- Jalpaiguri (2) Dipu Barman (23) S/O- Bimal Barman of Kalamjote, P.O- Sushrutanagar, P.S- Matigara, Dist- Darjeeling (3) Bibek Sarkar (24) S/o- Bidhan Sarkar of West Dhantala P.O- Satellite township, P.S- NJP, Dist- Jalpaiguri (4) Swapan Singha (36) S/O- Motilal Singha of Khajurmora, P.O - Ranidanga, P.S- Bagdogra, Dist- Darjeeling (5) Bhaskar Mukherjee (56) S/O- Bhabesh Ch Mukherjee of Ashoknagar, P.S- NJP Dist- Jalpaiguri In this regard, I beg to state that on 02.07.2021 at about 20:05hrs. While performing special mobile duty vide GDE No.54 DT: 02/07/2021, received information that some people are violating the order of Lockdown and roaming aimlessly at Chhatat Medical More. Informed O/C, Matigara PS and as per his direction, I along with force and had been to Chhatat Medical More under NBMC & Hospital OP and arrested the above noted five accused persons. Thereby completely violating the lockdown measures issued by Chief Secretary West Bengal vide order no. 618-ISS/2M-22/2020 DTD.30/04/2021 and 622-ISS/2M-22/2020 DTD. 1st May 2021 issued by the Ministry of Health & family Welfare, Government of India Order no. 403/2020-DM-1(A) Dtd.29/04/2021 and Order No.647-ISS/2M-22/2020 DTD.15/05/2021. On seeing police, they tried to flee away but somehow, the above noted persons could be apprehended. On interrogation, they disclosed their name and address as noted above. On further interrogation, they admitted that they were aware of the lockdown Order and Restrictions imposed upon the movement of human being and shops. As they has violated the Lockdown Order promulgate by the appropriate Government Authority and also the provision of Disaster Management Act, 2005, I with the help of force arrested them U/S 41 CrPC by issuing them memo of arrest.

I, therefore pray that a specific case under proper section of law may kindly be initiated against the above noted arrested accused persons.
