Subject: - FIR.

I, SI Maheshwar Ch Paul of NBMC OP under Matigara PS, SPC lodged a written complaint against the accused one Rakesh Sarkar (52) S/O- Rasendra Sarkar of Kawakhali Bazar, P.o- Sushrutanagar, P.S- Matigara, Dist- Darjeeling after producing him under arrest along with following articles:

- 1) 04 (Four) Indane LPG Cylinder (15.5 kg) NETT W 14.2 kg. (Red Color)
- 2) 04 (Four) LPG Cylinder (5 kg). Red Color
- 3) Weight Mechine.


To that effect that on 08/07/2021 in course of Special mobile duty vide NBMC OP GDE No- 246 Dtd- 08/07/2021 at around 14.15 hrs. I received source information that one person namely Rakesh Sarkar had been selling and storing of LPG Cylinders illegally near Kawakhali bazar. Accordingly, I shared the information with my officer in- charge and as per his direction; I along with Const/500 Mayaram Oraon of NBMC OP and Const/165 Dipiyoti Singha of SAP 4<sup>th</sup> under Matigara P.S had been to Kawakhali Bazar area. Subsequently, I along with forces reached at the house being shown by the source, I, then conducted raid in the house of above noted accused who possessing the above noted articles kept in his house and was selling the same. I demanded him the papers or license, cash memo of the said LPG Cylinder but he failed to produce any documents in support of possession of above noted LPG Cylinder. On interrogation, he disclosed his name as mentioned above and admitted that he procured the LPG Cylinder illegally and had been selling the same illegally to the people for monitorial gain. The above noted person had procured the essential commodity and sold it commercially without any valid license issued by the Government authorities. And thus violated the government orders. I, accordingly, seized those LPG Cylinder U/S 102 Cr.P.C in presence of Police witnesses, on 08/07/2021 in between 15.05 to 15.35 hrs under proper seizure list. Then, I arrested him U/S 41 Cr.P.C. The ground of arrest duly been communicated him.

Hence, I therefore pray that a specific case may kindly be started against the above noted person namely Rakesh Sarkar (52) S/O- Rasendra Sarkar of Kawakhali Bazar, P.O- Sushrutanagar, P.S- Matigara, Dist- Darjeeling under proper section of law and arrange for its investigation.
