Sir,

With due respect, I SI Dipankar Chakraborty of Bagdogra P.S. do hereby lodge this written complaint against the following arrested person namely i) Jagabandhu Barman 26yrs s/o Halewar Barman of Baniakhani Lalpool P.S, Matigra Dist, Darjeeling ii) Mintu Barman 24yrs s/o Dilip Barman of Baniakhani Lalpool P.S, Matigra Dist, Darjeeling iii) Ajit Singha 25yrs s/o Milan Singha of Bangoria P.S, Matigra Dist, Darjeeling iv) Shib Kumar Thakur 51yrs s/o Banka Lal Thakur of MES Bhujiapani P.S, Bagdogra Dist, Darjeeling for disobeying Government order vide Memo no 486/C5/2021 dated 24.04.2021 and order No 647-155/2M-22/2020 dated 15.05.2021.

The facts of the case in brief is that today on 09/07/2021 at about 17.05 hrs in course of Evening Naka duty vide Bagdogra P.S GDE No 492 Dated 06/07/2021 the above noted arrested persons were roaming at Bihar More area unnecessary also they did not wear face mask as the Government of West Bengal has issued various order vide Memo no 486/C5/2021 dated 24.04.2021 that wearing of facial mask and maintain social distance made mandatory in public places in the current pandemic disaster situation all persons are to strictly comply with the COVID-19 safety norms in effect from 6 AM Sunday 16<sup>th</sup> May to shall remain 6 PM 15<sup>th</sup> June 2021 vide order No 647-155/2M-22/2020 dated 15.05.2021 in terms of the provisions under Disaster Management Act 2005 read with West Bengal Epidemic Disease, Covid-19 Regulations 2020 unnecessary movement shall be strictly prohibited. Accordingly, I stop them and ask to reason for not wear of face mask and roaming unnecessary but they could not give any satisfactory reason also violate against our police party. It is pertinent to note here that since the outbreak of Second wave of Corona Virus awareness regarding wearing of face mask and maintain of social distancing had been conducted through mixing but the above noted persons had no botheration regarding their own safety and also the safety of others. Their act is dangerous so as to the spread of Corona Virus. Thereafter, I tried to convince them and directed to wear face mask but they denied to do so and started arguing with me. Finding no other alternative way, I apprehended them to avoid risks to human life and health.

Under the above facts and circumstances, I request you that a specific case against the aforementioned persons may kindly started with suitable sections of law.
