Sir.

With due regard and humble Submission I Smt. Chanda Mallick Wife of Sri Bikki Mallick, resident of Shustra Nagar, Medical. Kalamjote, P.S- Matigara, Dist- Darjeeling do hereby submit the following for your kind information and necessary legal action:-

1. That I was married to Bikki Mallick 12 years ago according to Hindu Rites and Customs and the marriage was solemnized at at the residence of my father at Raejendra Nagar, Ward No-I, P.O & P.S- PradhanNagar, Siliguri, Dist- Darjeeling and my father gave everything which is required .
2. That after marriage Bikki Mallick took me to his house at Shustra Nagar, Medical. Kalamjote, P.S- Matigara and for few months every things were quite good but just after the elapsed of 7 to 8 month my husband started to torture me physically and mentally and demanded money from me & force me to bring money from my parents' house and my provided as my husband will keep not torture me anymore.
3. That since beginning my husband use to torture me physically and mentally and I use to tolerate with a hope that my husband would change his nature and let me reside peacefully but in Vain.
4. That out of the said marriage five children were born and they are all minor namely 1, Khushi Kumari Mallick who is 11 years, 2, Bindya Mallick aged about 10 years, 3, Aaui Mallick aged about 8 years, 4. Pratigya Mallick aged about 6 years and 5. Debwansh Mallick son aged about 5 years.
5. That my husband beat /torture me regularly like a butcher after consuming Liquor and several times the matter was informed to the Police and my Parents and on each time my husband apologies and promise that he will not repeat his illegal act and activities upon me and will not torture me behave with me cruelly but all in vain
6. That my said husband is having illicit relation with one another Girl and he intend to marry her and for her he assault me regularly so that I leave the house and run away from his house and he do not provide sufficient money to purchase Ration /house hold goods for my survival & for children and my parent help me to pull the livings.
7. That my husband beat/assault & torture me and the minor children without any reason and abuse us in a very filthy language and do not provide sufficient food for survival and his cruelty upon me and the minor children are raising/incurring day to day rapidly.
8. That the nature and character of my husband is horrible and he never became a good husband and father and always torture us physically and mentally and is every time ready to oust/drag out us from house for his illegal act and activities.
9. That said husband always threaten me that he would murder me and the children if I do not leave the hose and not allow him to marry another Girl with whom he is having illicit relation.
10. That my husband have made my life hell and always torture me cruelly for his ill motive.
