Sub: - Complaint against 2 to 3 unknown miscreants for theft of 19 (nineteen) mobile phones alongwith its sphere parts on 12.07.2021 between 6 p.m. to 6.30 p.m. from Guddu Mobile Shop, Bidhan Market, Siliguri.

Respected Sir,

I, Md. Saidul, Son of Late Md. Baisaku, resident of Haguragachh, P.O- Chathat, P.S.- Phansidewa, Dist.- Darjeeling, would like to state that I have a mobile repairing shop at Chathat Bazar under the name and style of 'Suhana Communication' and during the period of partial lockdown, some customers gave their mobile phones for repairing to change their display which was broken or defected. The total number of defective mobile phones are 19 (nineteen) in number. That on 12.07.2021 at about 6 p.m. I went to Siliguri at the shop of Guddu Mobile situated at Ghosh Building, Arbinda Road, Bidhan Market carrying all the 19 sets of defective mobiles phones entrusted to me by my customers in a black brown colour backpack so as to buy the display and other parts required to repair the said mobile phones and after purchasing parts for the above numbered mobile I put them into my said Black-Brown colour backpack and was about to leave from there but at that time I got a phone call from my shop and I became engaged for two to three minutes in my

call and while talking I have kept my said backpack in a tool in front of the said Guddu Mobile Shop and after completing my conversation I found that my backpack was missing from the said Guddu Mobile Shop. Thereafter I searched all around the shop but was unable to find the said backpack. Later on I checked the CCTV footage of said shop and it revealed that my backpack was theft away by 2 to 3 unknown persons.

That after the incident I tried to contact with my customers to get the IMEI details of each and every mobile phones which are 19 in numbers but till date I only managed to collect two IMEI numbers of two mobile phones vide Model no. Oppo F17, IMEI No. 868015051830874 and 868015051830866, Model No. VIVO Y71, IMEI No. 868906035691715 and 868906035691707 and the rest IMEI Number of 17 mobile phones is still required to be collect by me which I will be able to collect.

However I had waited for these period of (7) seven days to communicate about the theft to my customers and collect the IMEI numbers of all the mobile phones prior to lodging this complaint but I only been able to collect IMEI numbers of (2) two mobile phones as mentioned above, So without any further delays I am lodging this complaint to you for theft of 19 mobile phones alongwith their spare parts by the unknown miscreants and would request you to investigate the matter so that the phone and the spare parts are recovered and the wrongdoer can be punished as per the procedure established by law
