Sir,

I, the undersigned, on behalf of the M/s Venture Supply Chain Pvt. Ltd Khasra No.831, Block-K-2, Mata Chowk, Mahipalpur, New Delhi-110037 and having branch office at Kanchanbari, Banglabasti, Fulbari-II, would like to inform you the following facts and circumstances:-

1. That M/s Venture Supply Chain Pvt. Ltd is the owner of vehicle no. NL-01AC-2874.
2. That on 08-08-2021 the above said truck / vehicle was hired by Amazon and as per the consignment the aforesaid vehicle was loaded with goods of Amazon Company on 04.30 p.m. from Banglabasti, New Jalpaiguri, for Raiganj, then Buniadpur, and Balurghat . The complainant company deputed a driver namely Subhan Hussain (DL No. UP2220180001380 Mob: 8477011835), son of Islam Husaain, resident of Dariaganj , Sadar Rampur, Uttar Pradesh
3. That during the journey the said driver Subhan Hussain picked up unauthorizely two more drivers namely Shanawaz(DL No.UP2220160006351, son of Ameer Ahmed, resident of House No.107, Vill-Milak Mohammad Bakash, Milak, Rampur, Uttarpradesh and Shakir Ali (DL No.UP2220150016469) , son of Jakir Ali, resident of House No. 22, Rampur, Bilaspur, Uttarpradesh with malafide intension.
4. That during the journey all the drivers with their common malafide intention to breached the trust the vehicle as well as goods loaded on the said truck, removed the GPS system installed in the said vehicle by the company and also removed the FASTAG system affixed with the vehicle and hide their location from the complainant company just to breached the trust the vehicle as well as goods of the said truck. and they malafidely took away the said vehicle and kept the same in their custody without our consent.
