Respected Sir,

With due respect, I, **SRI SUBRATA GHOSH**, Son of Late Kartick Chandra Ghosh, Resident of J.C. Bose Road, Subhas Pally, Siliguri, P.O. & P.S. Siliguri, Dist. Darjeeling, would like to lodge this written complaint to the effect that I am a business person and I have been carrying on a business of Contractory as a Enlisted Contractor of different Government Departments. Since my birth, myself and my family members have been residing in the aforesaid address and 5 years ago, I have constructed a new G+3 storied residential building in and over my landed property and after constructing the dwelling house, myself and my family members have started to reside therein. On 10/8/21 the morning at about 11.00 A.M., when my wife Smt. July Ghosh try to open the Locker of the Almirah in order to take her golden chain from the said locker, she found that the Lock of the Locker of the said Almirah in a broken condition and immediately, she informed the matter to me and thereafter, myself and my wife went to the room of the First Floor where the said Almirah was kept and found that the Lock of the said Locker in a broken condition and after opening the Locker, we found and noticed that all the valuable Golden Jewelleries and Cash amounting Rs. 20,000/- to Rs. 25,000/- approx (the details list of missing/stolen articles are mentioned below) are missing from the said Locker. It is to be mentioned here that my wife usually kept all her Golden Jewelleries and some amount of cash in the said Locker and the Keys of the

said Locker usually kept in the Almirah. It is also to be mentioned here that several visitors and our distance relatives have visited and stayed in our house in the past two months and it is our strong believe that someone might have stolen and taken away the valuable Golden Jewelries and Cash amount as mentioned below from the Locker installed in the Almirah without our consent after breaking the Lock of the said Locker.

I, therefore, request you to investigate into the matter properly and please take necessary legal steps against the person/s who are involved behind this crime and also recover our stolen valuable golden ornaments and cash amount as per the provision of law.
