Respected Sir,

With due respect I, Shri Arup Kumar Sarkar son of Late Nripendra-Nath Sarkar, Resident of 17th Jaytin Das Sarani, Ashram Para, Siliguri Ward no 14, P.O Siliguri, P.S Siliguri, District Darjeeling like to inform you that I am the branch in charge of The Janta Transport Corporation situated at Church Road, Siliguri and I am also the in charge of a vehicle (LP Truck) being Reg.No WB57A5343 and the said vehicle owner name is one Ramesh Kumar Jalan of 6A Tarachand Dutta Street, Kolkata 73 and since long I have been looking after the Janta Transport Corporation as well as said vehicle (LP Truck) being Reg No WB57A5343 and one Sujit Barman son of Nikunjay Barman Resident of village & post- Khapaidanga, District- Cooch Behar, P.S Kundi Bari, Pin- 736133 since long he is plying and looking after the said vehicle being Reg. No WB57A5343 as a driver and since long said Sujit Barman is neglecting and disobeying my instruction and he is not performing his duty as per my instruction and he is doing his duty most unethically, negligently and illegally and since long he is stealing vehicle's fuel i.e Mobil/Diesel and on many occasion he could not give me the satisfactory answer regarding use of fuel in vehicle and I warned him on several occasion but he did not pay any heed to my words and he continued his illegal activities and it is pertinent to mention herein that we use to deal Medicine Transportation to various place in West Bengal and our job is time bound and we have to carry life-saving drugs and our job is very serious one but this man did not perform his duty in proper time in proper manner and he always neglects his duty and avoid my phone calls or my other men calls and most of the time he use to perform his duty in drunken condition on so many occasion I warned him but he did not pay any heed to my words and he continues his illegal acts and activities and on 18.08.2021 I loaded life saving drugs/medicine for Cooch Behar, Alipurduar, Dhupguri and Falakata and I also gave expenses of Rs 11758=00 Rupees(eleven thousand, seven hundred fifty-eight) and proper documents of loaded life saving drugs/medicines and proper vehicle papers to said person at about 9 p.m from my office situated at Church Road at the time of handing over the vehicle the fuel tank was completely full with the capacity of 360 liters after getting the amount said driver suddenly fled away keeping the vehicle its key and all the documents relating to vehicle and medicines and on several occasion I tried to trace him out and I made several phone calls to said driver (9933522002) but my all efforts were in vain and in every time I find his mobile phone in switched off condition having no other alternative I sent my another driver MD Baharul for delivery of those life saving medicines/drugs to said destination i.e Cooch Behar, Alipurduar, Dhupguri and Falakata and from my said driver MD Baharul informed me that approximately 150 liters Diesel is short/missing in fuel Tank and value of said deisel is approximately Rs 13,800=00 (Rupees thirteen thousand eight hundred) and same is stolen by said driver Sujit Barman and since 18.08.2021 I am constantly trying to contact and trace out said Sujit Barman but in all times I find his mobile (9933522002) is switched off and said Sujit Barman has stolen altogether Rs 25,558=00 (Rupees twenty-five thousand five hundred fifty-eight) which includes cash of Rs 11,758=00 Rupees(eleven thousand seven hundred fifty-eight) and 150 liters Diesel value of which is approximately Rs 13,800=00 (Rupees thirteen thousand eight hundred) having no other alternative I am lodging this complaint to you for recovery of money as well as fuel and I also seek for justice and said driver is required to be booked in a specific case and he is required to be punish as per the provisions of law of land for his illegal acts and activities.
