**Sub : Lodgement of F.I.R.**

**Complaint against Mrs. Debi Debnath (Ph. No. 80165-59451), Wife of Sri Kanai Debnath, resident of Fagdaibari Bazar, Siliguri.**

I submit hereunder chronologically the incidents as under :-

1. My only son Late Sri Sumit Karmakar, aged 35 years died on 29<sup>th</sup> July, 21, 11.10 P.M. at Mukherjee Nursing Home, Siliguri after his continuous suffering on Covid-19 Positive case.
2. During the time period of the rituals, my husband, Sri Bisweswar Karmakar, aged 78 years felt sick due to the loss of son followed by piles problem. Considering the ailment and its seriousness, I was compelled to put him into the Basu Nursing Home, Siliguri under the care of Dr. Samarjit Banik & Dr. C. M. Basu. Keeping in view his illness as well as to perform the rituals, the above Doctors ultimately discharged him with the advice of keeping made (Aaya) 24 hours for caring as well as periodical application of medicine at the affected place of piles.
3. Two Aayas were duly taken by us from the above Nursing Home references, of which one for the day service and the another for night service with a split of 12 hours duty at our house. In the gradual process of the recovery of my husband and to avoid the financial burden, I release the day time service provided by one Aaya and retained the night service Aaya, whose name is Mrs. Debi Debnath.
4. During the entire period of services of Aaya my elder daughter, Ms. Bhaswati Karmakar, Sri Prabir Karmakar (husband of Bhaswati Karmakar) have been staying with me.
5. I intend to release the services of Mrs. Debi Debnath with effect from today (21-08-2021) due to unbearable financial burden and my above daughter told her so alongwith cleaning of urine pot, bed pans being used by my husband for his illness.

6. Yesterday I traced that Rupees ten thousand only was missing and ultimately noted the same amount has been stolen by her (Debi Debnath) as none of outsiders were in my house.
7. Upon hearing of the intimation conveyed my daughter, she became erratic, used filthy languages addressed to my daughter, me and my husband. She was so brutal at that moment, she slapped to my daughter, and pushed my husband with an attempt to murder and lot of dirty languages used by her addressed to me and all my family members. Moreover, she rushed out from my building and moved out to the public road by shouting filthy languages which was noticed by the adjacent neighbourers.
8. After sometimes that lady came with lot of goondas for threatening to us. The attempt was so rough that any untoward happening may occur if our main door of the building was kept opened. They have also given lot of life threats to our family.
9. I was so scared and I took Police Assistance by making telephone calls to your office. I convey my thanks for immediate providing the Police service at my house for examination of the situation/circumstances.

In light of the above back drops, I like to state that it is a case of attempt to murder, tarnish the image of our family in the eyes of neighbourers, theft of money from our house and future threats to me and my family.

You are, therefore, requested to take a corrective action so that any further happening may not occur in future.
