Subject: F.I.R for, Theft of Electricity via Meter Bypass.

Sir,

I, Suman Sengupta, Son of Ashoke Sengupta, O.E & SM Power House CCC, empowered by The Electricity Act 2003 amended on 2007 of India do here by lodge this complain against Sajal Mandal S/O Tufani Mandal, Janata Nagar, Sevoke Road, Behind Post Office, P.S- Bhakti Nagar, Dist- Jalpaiguri, Consumer id- 412033108, Meter no- L3308379. While on a routine inspection on 01.09.2021, I, Suman Sengupta, Divisional Engineer & Station Manager, Power House CCC along with Sanjay Prasad,O.E., Power House CCC, WBSEDCL, visited the premises. The site being at Janata Nagar, Sevoke Road, Behind Post Office, P.S- Bhakti Nagar, Dist- Jalpaiguri.

We entered the premises on 01.09.2021 at 12.51 Hrs after serving notice to Sri Sajal Mandal. On Physical inspection at the premises, we detected energy theft via bypassing of the energy meter of Landies & Gyer make, with a present reading of 3277 kWh bearing meter no L3308379. The Consumer ID (412033108) is in the name of Tufani Mandal. But it was found that Sri Sajal Mandal S/O Tufani Mandal is the current occupier of the premise and has been enjoying power unauthorizedly.

Thus the accused were enjoying power via meter bypass in the premises for domestic purpose. Thereby committing a crime as per The Electricity Act 2003 amended on 2007 of India under section 135 (1) (b). It was also found that there are 1. Tube Light of 1 nos - 60 watts. 2. Bulb of 1 nos -200 watt. Thus a total load detection was of 260 watts. After detection of Energy Theft the Service Connection was disconnected and the service cable and Meter was Seized & labelled. A Copy of each Inspection list, Seizure list (Power cable 6 Sqmm, black in colour of 15 feet approx) & Notice was served to Sajal Mandal, S/O Tufani Mandal. We exited the Premises at 13.15 hrs.

Thus you are requested to kindly initiate an investigation against Sajal Mandal under Section 135 (1) (b) of the Electricity act 2003 amended on 2007 of India.
