
Sir,

With due respect & humble submission, I, SI Simanta Chatterjee of Bhaktinagar PS, SPC lodged a written complaint to the effect that on 29.09.2021 at about 22.10 hrs received source information that one person of Bihar had been kidnapped and kept somewhere in bottle company more and the kidnapers had been demanding money for his release. I shared the information with I.C. PS and accordingly, he directed me to work out the information and myself along with available officers and force left to work out the information. Noted the fact vide GDE No. 1545 Dated 29.09.2021, I along with force had been to Bottle Company more, Ward No-41, PS Bhaktinagar Dist Jalpaiguri and as shown and identified by the source conducted raid in the house of Tipu and recovered and rescued one Sambhu Paswan (34) S/O Lt. Jogindar Paswan of Bahuarha, PO - Dhanuja, PS - Phulparas, Dist. Madhubani, Bihar. On examination, Sambhu Paswan stated that he was kidnapped and detained by Souvik Kundu @ Tipu of Bottle Company More and his associates since 27/28.07.2021 and was kept in the room with the help of (i) Hemu Ojha, (ii) Bappa Das @ Matta, (iii) Baban of NJP and others, demanding money from his family members for his return. It could be learnt that Tipu had supplied liquor amounting to Rs. 3 lakhs to Bihar and the same was caught by Bihar Police and in order to refund the said amount, Souvik Kundu @ Tipu and his associates namely Hemu Ojha, Bappa Das @ Matta and Baban of NJP and others kidnapped him and detained him unlawfully and demanded ransom from victims family. The victim's family somehow managed to pay approx. Rs. 80,000/- as ransom to Tipu through account transfer. In order to extort money the alleged persons used to inflict physical torture upon him.


Under the above circumstance I request you that a specific case may kindly be started against (i) Souvik Kundu @ Tipu of Bottle Company More, (ii) Hemu Ojha, (iii) Bappa Das @ Matta (iv) Baban and others and arranged proper investigation of the case.
