Sub.: F.I.R of pilferage of 5nos. electrical motors(Govt, property) of High Mast Light Poles inside Dabgram Industrial Park, WBIIDC area.

Apropos, we would like to invite your kind attention that today it has been detected on taking up our regular maintenance work of the High Mast Poles inside Dabgram Industrial Park, WBIIDC area that 5(five) nos. of electrical motors from five High Mast Poles out of 8 nos. of Poles have been stolen by some unidentified person(s).

The High Mast Poles are Govt. properties and our Association is the authorised custodian of the Poles for maintenance work.

The electrical motors are installed inside the High Mast Poles secured with lid to be opened only with specific size allen key bolts and we can confirm that one of the motors inside the Pole being situated at our Parking area in front of Maharashtra Feed Factory was intact in position on last Saturday (02.10.2021) and the same has been detected stolen today along with other.


Our maintenance staff Sri Rinku Sarker has reported to our office today that he found five motors missing from five High Mast Poles while he has taken up his regular maintenance work.

We would like to request you to undertake investigation of the matter and to take appropriate measure to recover the Govt. properties as mentioned above.
