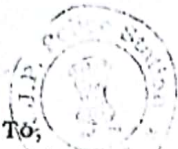

Sir,

With due respect, I am producing herewith the arrested accused persons namely (i) Md Mohubul (28 yrs) S/O Abdul Rashid of Chocha, PS- Baisi, Dist.- Purnia, Bihar (ii) Ganga Roy (32 yrs) S/O Tula Roy of Murtajapur, PS- Murtajapur Makund, Dist.- Baisali, Bihar and (iii) Md Makim (37 yrs) S/O Md Mustakin of Sonapur main Road, PS- Chopra, Dist. Uttar Dinajpur and the following articles under seizure :-

1. One truck having registration number BR/11/T/4166 loaded with 14 (forteen) numbers of buffalo with 14 (forteen) numbers of calf in different age, size and colour
2. One truck having registration number BR/01/GJ/3074 loaded with 14 (forteen) numbers of buffalo with 14 (forteen) numbers of calf in different age, size and colour
3. One pick up having registration number WB/73/F/6071 loaded with 04 (four) number of cattle with 04 numbers of calf in different age, size and colour.

I, ASI Amal Debnath of NJP PS, Siliguri Police Commissionerate beg to state that on 05.10.21 at 09.05 hrs I received a secret source information that three vehicles having registration number (i) BR/11/T/4166 (ii) BR/01/GJ/3074 and (iii) WB/73/F/6071 loaded with stolen cattle and buffalo which were procured by stolen or fraudulent means are coming from Ghosh pukur side. Accordingly, I informed the fact to O/C, NJP PS and directed the fact in general diary vide NJP PS GDE No 215 dated 05.10.21 and as per order myself along with ASI Sajal Das, ASI Khagen Barman, VP/08 Laxman Roy, VP/13 Jamirul Islam, CV/306 Biswajit Roy left for Fulbari Toll Plaza to work out the information in hand. At about 09.35 hrs we arrived at Fulbari Toll Plaza and started to Naka checking in order to intercept the said vehicles. At about 10.05 hrs we noticed that the above noted vehicles coming from Ghosh Pukur side. We managed to intercept above noted three vehicles at Fulbari Toll Plaza. On verification we found one person is seating inside vehicle No BR/11/T/4166 who disclosed his identity as Md Mohubul (28 yrs) S/O Abdul Rashid of Chocha, PS- Baisi, Dist.- Purnia Bihar and on search it is found that 14 (forteen) numbers of buffalo with 14 (forteen) numbers of calf in different age, size and colour loaded in the said vehicle, one person is seating inside vehicle No BR/01/GJ/3074 who disclosed his identity as Ganga Roy (32 yrs) S/O Tula Roy of Murtajapur, PS- Murtajapur Makund, Dist.- Baisali, Bihar and on search it is found that 14 (forteen) numbers of buffalo with 14 (forteen) numbers of calf in different age, size and colour loaded in the said vehicle and one person is seating in vehicle number WB/73/F/6071 who disclosed his identity as Md Makim (37 yrs) S/O Md Mustakin of Sonapur main Road, PS- Chopra, Dist. Uttar Dinajpur and on search it is found that 04 (four) numbers of cattle with 04 numbers of calf in different age, size and colour loaded in the said vehicle. On demand they failed to produce any valid documents/purchase invoice in respect of carrying cattles/ buffalo in their respective vehicles. They also failed to produce any permit for carrying livestock in the vehicles and also failed to produce any medical check up certificate in respect of such cattles/ buffalo which is a mandatory provision of law before transporting of cattle/ buffalo. I also asked them to produce any supporting documents in respect of carrying/transporting the cattle/buffalo if any but they failed to produce the same. During further interrogation they admitted that cattles/ buffalo were procured by some cattle smugglers by illegal means from Bihar side in order to supply the same to Assam to make huge profit.
