Respected Sir,

With due respect I ASI Tamal Paul Investigating officer of Kotwali PS Case No. 446/21 dated 07/09/21 u/s 379/411 IPC r/w sec 11(i)(d)(e) of Prevention of Cruelty of Animals act would like to lodge a written complaint against one NGO Animal Help Line, Siliguri.

I beg to state that on 07.09.21 on the basis of written complaint of ASI Majidul Haque of Kotwali PS, case no.446/21 was started against the accused person Harjinder Singh s/o Sri Raj Singh of Balabusty, PS Sangrur, Punjab. In this case fifteen (15) numbers of puppies of different breeds and eight (08) numbers of Persian cats were recovered and seized. After the registry of the case and the forwarding of the accused person, the seized 15 puppies and 08 cats were given in zimmanama to a NGO named and styled as Animal Help Line, Jalpaiguri Unit. Later the Ld. Court has approved said zimmanam in respect of this pet animal. The members of the NGO informed on 14.09.21 that two puppies (Rottweiler) died. Accordingly their post-mortem examination was done. But again today on 20.09.2021 received a message from IC Pradhan Nagar PS, Siliguri vide Org No. 4449/21 dt 18.09.21 that a message was received from Rabi Roy, Officer-in-charge of Animal Helpline, Siliguri that again two puppies have died on 18.09.21. After learning the fact I made contact with Mr. Krishnayan Dasgupta over telephone, member of NGO and he also confirmed that in total six numbers of puppies have expired till date. On 14/09/21 two Rottweiler, on 18/09/21 one Beagle, one Chow Chow and on 20.09.21 one Pug and one Golden Retriever have expired. It is further learnt that due to Malnutrition and lack of proper care these pet dogs are died and it is also mentioned in the message of IC Pradhan Nagar PS, Siliguri. The NGO misguided us while taking zimma of the seized puppies and cats by saying that they will be taken proper care of and will be provided with sufficient food. But they failed to keep up with their terms and as a result six puppies died.

Under the above circumstances, I pray before you for taking action against the NGO Animal Helpline Siliguri as per law.

Sub: Prayer for handing over the case to Pradhan Nagar P.S., Jalpaiguri

Respected Sir,

The brief fact of the case is that on 20.09.2021 at 22:45 hrs ASI Tamal Paul of Kotwali PS lodged a written complaint against one NGO Animal Help Line, Siliguri to the effect that on 07.09.21 on the basis of written complaint of ASI Majidul Haque of Kotwali PS, case no.446/21 was started against the accused person Harjinder Singh s/o Sri Raj Singh of Balabusty, PS Sangrur, Punjab. In this case fifteen (15) numbers of puppies of different breeds and eight (08) numbers of Persian cats were recovered and seized. After the registry of the case and the forwarding of the accused person, the seized 15 puppies and 08 cats were given in zimmanama to a NGO named and styled as Animal Help Line, Jalpaiguri Unit. Later the Ld. Court has approve said zimmanama in respect of this pet animal. The members of the NGO informed on 14.09.21 that two puppies (Rottweiler) died. Accordingly their post-mortem examination was done. But again today on 20.09.2021 received a message from IC Pradhan Nagar PS, Siliguri vide Org No. 4449/21 dt 18.09.21 that a message was received from Rabi Roy, Officer-in-charge of Animal Helpline, Siliguri that again two puppies have died on 18.09.21. After learning the fact he made contact with Mr. Krishnayan Dasgupta over telephone, member of NGO and he also confirmed that in total six numbers of puppies have expired till date. On 14/09/21 two Rottweiler, on 18/09/21 one Beagle, one Chow Chow and on 20.09.21 one Pug and one Golden Retriever have expired. It is further learnt that due to Malnutrition and lack of proper care these pet dogs are died and also mentioned in the message of IC Pradhan Nagar PS, Siliguri. The NGO misguided us while taking zimma of the seized puppies and cats by saying that they will be taken proper care of and will be provided with sufficient food. But they failed to keep up with their terms and as a result six puppies died. On the basis of the complaint started Kotwali P.S. Case No. 484/21 Dt. 20.09.21 u/s 429 IPC and endorsed to PSI Passang Temba Sherpa for its investigation.

During investigation it is learnt from the members of other NGO that the P.O. falls under Pradhan Nagar Police Station, SPC, as the Animal Helpline is Siliguri based NGO and the puppies and cats are kept at Siliguri, Pradhan Nagar area where the same have expired. I also communicated with I/C Pradhan Nagar P.S. and learnt that the puppies have expired at Animal Helpline NGO Office, Siliguri, Pradhan Nagar area and for this the members of Animal Helpline informed him regarding the death of the puppies. Hence, as the P.O. is Pradhan Nagar P.S. jurisdiction, an order may kindly be passed to hand over the investigation of this case to I/C Pradhan Nagar P.S. and obliged me.
