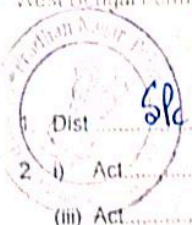

Sir,

This is to bring to your kind notice that I along with my brother-in-law are the owners-in possession of the below Scheduled land, measuring about 16 Kathas and 8 Chattaks of land in Mouza Kalkut, P.S. Pradhannagar, which has been described more fully in the Schedule below, by virtue of two registered Deeds of Sale. And we are in possession of aforesaid land since our purchase in the year 2005. The aforesaid land has been mutated in our names, and we have been paying land revenue in our names, and new Khatians have also been opened in our names. And after purchase we constructed a boundary wall of 2 and half feet around our lands.

In May, 2017, we decided to construct our houses on the below Scheduled land and with that aim in view we started to elevate our boundary wall. But some miscreants/ land brokers, viz. Ujjal Singh, Bishal Sharma, Manoj Singh, Lakhi Singh, all residents of Debidanga, Champasari, P.S. Pradhannagar, stopped our construction work. When we approached the Police, the Officer advised us to approach the civil court. And we were compelled to file a suit, being T.S. no. 145 of 2017, in the Court of the Ld. Civil Judge, Junior Division, Siliguri, against the aforesaid persons.

After four long years, after holding of a local investigation by the court, on 21<sup>st</sup> September, 2021, the Ld. Judge, was pleased to pass an injunction order in our favour.

On 10-10-2021, we started to continue to repair of the boundary wall as it has been damaged severely.

On the evening of 29<sup>th</sup> October, 2021, the aforesaid persons came to the below Scheduled land and threatened me. Thereafter, I received call from your PS asking me to meet you with my documents, at 11 am, along with the miscreants, ACP, Manish Kumar Yadav.

After the aforesaid meeting when I went to the below Scheduled land, at about 1.30 pm, the aforesaid miscreants along with 40 hooligans came to the spot and broke my boundary wall, and ran away. At the time of breaking the wall they said we are breaking the wall as per order of the police. The miscreants had come in a white car bearing the following no. BR 01DN 7491.

Under the circumstances I request you to take strong and necessary action as per law against the aforesaid persons as early as possible.
