Sub:-Complaint for torture, cruelty, harassment and dowry demand against husband Sri. Utam Das, son of Narayan Das and mother-in-law Smt. Sarathi das, both resident of Patiramjote, Matigara, Siliguri, Darjeeling- 734010.

Respected Madam,

I, Smt. Sukla Das, wife of Sri Uttam Das, daughter of Arjun Das, resident of Pragati Para, Siliguri, Bhaktinagar, Jalpaiguri, got married to my husband in January, 2009 in the house of my father at Jalpaimore, Pragati Para, Ward No. 21 of SMC. Out of love and affection towards me, my father gave the amount Rs. 25,000/-, one gold ring along with some furniture such as bed, almirah etc. to my in-laws during my marriage. Once I reached to my matrimonial home at Matigara, Patiramjote, Patiram, Darjeeling- 734010, my husband and my mother-in-law complained that my parents had not given me enough money and furniture in marriage so my mother-in-law asked me to handover my jewellery to her. I have not seen those jewelleries since that day. From the very day of my marriage, my husband Uttam Das and my mother-in-law Sarathi Das had started torturing me physically and mentally and forced me to bring money from my father. As I did not take money from my father as per their demand, they abused me with filthy language, even my mother-in-law slapped me several times in front of my husband but he never stopped his mother from doing so rather he encouraged his mother. My mother-in-law, Sarathi Das used to speak lie about me to the neighbors stayed in the same area. On 20.12.2012 my elder daughter was born namely Dulali Das and on 10.02.2015 my younger daughter namely Rupali Das was born. After having children I thought they would stop demanding dowry but they continuously tortured me for dowry even

in front my daughters. They beat my daughters also. My mother-in-law used to say me that she chose me for her son, so she can demand dowry and I have to pay/fulfill their demand. But for me it was not possible to bring money from my parents' house as my father's financial condition was not well.

At last they drove me away from my matrimonial home and since then I am living in my father's house at Pragati Para, Siliguri, Bhaktinagar, Jalpaiguri. Soon I came to know that my mother-in-law fixed a marriage of my husband with someone else and my husband was ready to marry that person and I also came to know that on 21.11.2021 my husband is going to marry with someone else. Moreover my husband and my mother-in-law used to torture my daughters physically as because I did not fulfill their (my husband and my mother-in-law) demands of dowry. They are very desperate and dangerous in nature. They locked my daughters and not allowed them to meet anyone not even me as they knew that if they tortured my daughters, I will be bound to fulfil their demands. Recently I and my brother Ajay Das went to my in-laws house to bring back my daughters, they did not give them back rather they beat me and my brother and banished us from their house.

Thus, I therefore, request you to take appropriate action against my mother-in-law and husband for torturing and demanding dowry and also I am requesting to help me to get my daughters back.
