Sir,

I, SI. Diptajit Dhar S/O. Rabindra Nath Dhar now attached to Siliguri P.S. SPC Producing herewith four accused persons namely i) Nabin Sarkar (30 yrs) S/O- Lt. Ramesh Sarkar of Parimal Nagar, PS- Matigara, Dist- Darjeeling ii) Nanda Mahanta (21/M) S/O- Nirod Mahanta of Parimal Nagar, PS- Matigara, Dist- Darjeeling iii) Dipak Barman (21/M) S/O- Narayan Barman of Parimal Nagar, PS- Matigara, Dist- Darjeeling iv) Chiranjit Das (20M) S/O- Ajay Das of Parimal Nagar, PS- Matigara, Dist- Darjeeling and one truck Reg. No. WB-73/ 2074 loaded with Sand without any Paper.

In this regard I beg to state that on dated 19/11/2021 during special naka duty at Airview More, Vide Siliguri PS GDE NO. 1081 Dated : 19/11/21 then at 22.15 hrs found one truck having Reg No. WB/73/2074 coming towards the Naka Point from Pradhan nagar Side, accordingly myself along with force gave signal to stop the said truck. Accordingly the truck stopped and we disclosed our identity to the said truck driver. On being search found the truck loaded with sand and on further search found the above noted four persons including the driver Nabin Sarkar boarded on the truck. Accordingly I demanded documents in-respect of carrying the sand but they failed to produce any valid documents regarding the sand and they stated that they procured the sand fraudulently somewhere from Sutkigudam Ghat, Matigara side and taking the sand for disposal through Pradhan nagar somewhere at Siliguri for their wrongful gain, violating the terms and condition of the Mines and Minerals Development Regulations Act. 1957. Accordingly I seized the truck loaded with sand and arrested the driver and helpers of the truck as noted above in between 22.15 hrs to 22.35 hrs and arrested them accordingly.

Hence I am pray before you that necessary legal action may kindly be taken against the arrested accused persons namely i) Nabin Sarkar (30 yrs) S/O- Lt. Ramesh Sarkar of Parimal Nagar, PS- Matigara, Dist- Darjeeling ii) Nanda Mahanta (21/M) S/O- Nirod Mahanta of Parimal Nagar, PS- Matigara, Dist- Darjeeling iii) Dipak Barman (21/M) S/O- Narayan Barman of Parimal Nagar, PS- Matigara, Dist- Darjeeling iv) Chiranjit Das (20M) S/O- Ajay Das of Parimal Nagar, PS- Matigara, Dist- Darjeeling and owner of Truck Reg No. WB/73/2074 loaded with Sand materials and other involved in this matter.
