Sir,

With due respect, I am producing herewith 02 (two) arrested accused persons namely (i) Gobinda Saha (59 yrs) S/O late Madhu Sudan Saha and (ii) Biplob Sarkar (27 yrs) S/O Netai Ch Sarkar both of Kalam Jote, PO- Sushruta Nagar, PS- Matigara, Dist.- Darjeeling under arrest and 01 improvised small Fire arm (One shooter) measuring 19.5 cm in length including its 10 CM barrel with one trigger, striking hammer, striking pin and in working condition and 01 (one) round live ammunition seized from the possession of the said accused persons. The ground of arrest duly been communicated with them.

I ASI Khagen Barman of NJP PS, SPC do hereby lodge this written complaint against the above noted two arrested accused Persons namely (i) Gobinda Saha (59 yrs) S/O late Madhu Sudan Saha and (ii) Biplob Sarkar (27 yrs) S/O Netai Ch Sarkar both of Kalam Jote, PO- Sushruta Nagar, PS- Matigara, Dist.- Darjeeling. In this regard I beg to report that today i.e. on 24.11.21 at 20.40 hrs I received a secret information that two persons are standing below Mahananda River with fire arms and ammunition for its clandestine disposal to respective their customers. Accordingly diarised the information in General diary vide NJP PS GDE No 1010 dated 24.11.21 and informed the fact to you. As per kind order and direction myself along with, ASI Sajal Das, C/1053 Paresh Rava, VP/13 Jamirul Islam, VP/08 Laxman Roy and CV/306 Bisawajit Roy left for Porajhar to work out the information in hand by Govt. vehicle. At about 21.05 hrs we reached at the spot i.e. below Mahananda Bridge, Porajhar and as indicated by source we noticed that two persons were standing in a dark place below Mahanda Bridge, Porajhar under PS- NJP, Dist.- Jalpaiguri. We cordoned the place and managed to apprehended two persons. On being asked they disclosed their name and identity as noted above. We very carefully searched both the persons and found 01 (one) improvised small Fire arm (One shooter) from the possession of accused Biplob Sarkar which he was carrying in his waist concealed underneath the shirt and 01 (one) live ammunition from the possession of accused Gobinda Saha which he kept in the right pocket of his pant. During further interrogation they disclosed that they came there with fire arms and ammunition with a view to sale the same to their respective customers for their illegal gain. On demand they failed to produce any document in support the said improvised fire arm and ammunition which were found from their possession. Thus when their involvement in carrying and possessing illegal fire arm and ammunition was established, I seized the said improvised fire arms and ammunition under proper seizure list duly signed by them as well as by available witnesses between 21.45 hrs and 22.15 hrs on 24.11.21 and arrested them by preparing memo of arrest informing them about the ground of arrest.

Under the above noted facts and seizure of incriminating articles there is strong reason to believe that the accused persons namely (i) Gobinda Saha (59 yrs) S/O late Madhu Sudan Saha and (ii) Biplob Sarkar (27 yrs) S/O Netai Ch Sarkar both of Kalam Jote, PO- Sushruta Nagar, PS- Matigara, Dist.- Darjeeling are desperate and dangerous in nature, as they were carrying the said fire arm and live ammunition with an objective to commit heinous crime in the area or for its clandestine disposal to their customers for their wrongfull gain.

As they have willfully violated the regulation of Arms Act, So, I pray before you for starting a case against two arrested accused persons namely (i) Gobinda Saha (59 yrs) S/O late Madhu Sudan Saha and (ii) Biplob Sarkar (27 yrs) S/O Netai Ch Sarkar both of Kalam Jote, PO- Sushruta Nagar, PS- Matigara, Dist.- Darjeeling under appropriate section of law and arrange for its investigation.


