Sir,

In producing here with the one accused person namely- Lakhan Karmakar @ Santu Karmakar 31 yrs S/O Shree Jagadish Karmakar of Dashrath Pally Bazar, near Joy Medical w/no 44 PS- Bhaktinagar Dist- Jalpaiguri along with the following seized articles as per proper seizure list:

1. Eighteen (18) bottles of Himalayan Gold 60 up country spirit each bottle containing 600 ml.

I, ASI Rabin Lama of Bhaktinagar PS under Siliguri Police Commissionerate lodged a written complaint against the above noted accused person to the effect that on 27/11/2021 at 15.55 hrs during my special raid duty vide Bhaktinagar PS GDE no 1585 dated- 27/11/2021, received a source information that one person namely Lakhan Karmakar @ Santu has gathered huge quantity of liqu or illegally in his hotel name and style as Maa Kamakhya hotel Sevoke road, in front of Cosmos mall, for selling the same to his design customers for his wrongful gain. Accordingly the fact informed to IC PS and as per his kind instruction, me along with ASI Dipak Karmakar, constable 762 Mujibul Rahaman and CVF- 614 Sumit Kr Roy and CVF- 935 Biplab Roy had been to Maa Kamakhya hotel Sevoke road in front of Cosmos Mall to work out the source information. At about 16.15 hrs we reached at Maa Kamakhya Hotel as per identify by the source, and conducted raid in the Maa Kamakhya Hotel and apprehended one person and recovered Eighteen (18) bottles of Himalayan Gold 60 up country spirit each containing 600 ml. from his hotel which is containing in a Nylon bag, on demand he failed to produce any valid Licence/documents in support of said liquor. On interrogation he disclosed his name and address as Lakhan Karmakar @ Santu Karmakar 31 yrs S/O Shree Jagadish Karmakar of Dasarath Pally Bazar, near Joy Medical w/no 44 PS- Bhaktinagar Dist- Jalpaiguri, and he admitted that he sell the same to his design customer in open market from since long for his wrongful gain. Accordingly I seized Eighteen (18) bottles of Himalayan Gold 60 up country spirit (each bottle containing 600 ml) from the possession the possession of Lakhan Karmakar @ Santu Karmakar 31 yrs S/O Shree Jagadish Karmakar of Dashrath Pally Bazar, near Joy Medical w/no 44 PS- Bhaktinagar Dist- Jalpaiguri the seizure was made between 16.35 hrs to 16.55 hrs in presence of witnesses duly sign by the accused as well as witnesses. As he violated the rules and norms of Bengal Excise Act as such I arrested the accused person u/s 41 Cr.P.C in presence of his brother Bappa Karmakar appraising him the ground of arrest and issued arrest memo.

I, therefore pray before your kind honour that a specific case may be started against the accused person namely Lakhan Karmakar @ Santu Karmakar 31 yrs S/O Shree Jagadish Karmakar of Dashrath Pally Bazar, near Joy Medical w/no 44 PS- Bhaktinagar Dist- Jalpaiguri under proper section of law and arrange for its investigation.
