Respected Sir,

With due respect, I **POOJA SASTRI**, Wife of Anindra Majumder Sastri, residing at Akshaydeep Complex, Block-2B6, Second Floor, 28 Girish Ghosh Sarani, P.S. Siliguri, Dist. Darjeeling beg to state that I am residing in the aforesaid flat since the date of my marriage. At present I alongwith my husband and my son(4 years old) are residing in the said flat.

Since 10/10/2019, one Deepa Das, wife of Dipal Das, resident of Niranjana Nagar, Ghogomali, P.S. Bhaktinagar, Dist. Jalpaiguri used to work in my house who was appointed by my husband as the caretaker of our child.

On 24/10/2021 i.e. on the occasion of Karva Chauth, inadvertently I had left the keys of my almirah and lockers in an open drawer. Thereafter, till 02/11/2021, I have not opened my almirah or lockers, but on 03/11/2021, in the morning when I have opened the locker of my almirah, after looking into it I found that my valuable things i.e. two gold coins weighing 8 Grams each, Half set Jewelry, Gold Chain weighing 20 Grams with Gold pendent weighing about 5 Grams, two gold Bangles, One Gold Chain(Tanishq Brand) weighing 24 Grams, one piece of Gold bar weighing 20 grams, my son's Gold bangles weighing 14 Grams, are missing from my said locker. I have tried my level best since 3rd November to trace out the valuable items but I could not trace out the same. When I have enquired the matter by asking my maid and child caretaker, surprisingly from 16/11/2021, my said child caretaker namely Deepa Das has not been coming to my house for doing her job. I am sure that my abovenamed caretaker Deepa Das has stolen away the above mentioned valuable things for her illegal gain in conspiracy with her husband Dipal Das. It is to be mentioned here that after completion of work of our caretaker, her husband namely Dipal Das used to enter into my house for taking back his wife. My father-in-law is a reputed person, as such initially I have not lodged any complaint before the police station for avoiding legal complications and with a hope that the matter will be solved by ourselves. Thereafter, I alongwith my husband on several occasion have tried to contact with said Deepa Das and her husband but even after several assurance she did not come and since last two days Deepa Das and her husband Dipal Das have been neglecting and refusing our phone call.

Therefore, I request you to look into the matter and to take necessary legal steps for tracing out the above mentioned things / items and to take necessary legal action against said Deepa Das and Dipal Das. And for this kindness, I shall much oblige to you.
