I, Suman Sengupta, Son of Ashoke Sengupta, D.E & SM Power House CCC, empowered by The Electricity Act 2003 amended on 2007 of India do here by lodge this complaint against Sri. Abhay Barman (ph no- 7584022183), S/O Lt Bocha Barman , resident of Chota Fafri, Kalibari Road, P.S Bhaktinagar, Dist Jalpaiguri, West Bengal. While on a routine inspection on the site having consumer id 412196653, meter no P1513954, having power connection by WBSEDCL in the name of Sri. Abhay Barman in the address being Chota Fafri, Kalibari Road, P.S Bhaktinagar, Dist Jalpaiguri, West Bengal, , I, Suman Sengupta, Divisional Engineer & Station Manager, Power House CCC along with Sri Apurba Mitra , Junior Manager, Power House CCC, WBSEDCL and other technical staffs observed that the terminal seal of the meter was broken and energy was being used bypassing the energy meter.

We entered the premises at 1250hrs on 20.12.2021 after handing over Notice to Sri Swapan Barman, Son Of Sri Abhay Barman. Then it was observed that the power was being used in an unauthorized manner via directly bypassing the energy meter and breaking the terminal seal of the energy meter. The connection of the said consumer was already disconnected due to non payment of outstanding bill amount of Rs 13000/-. Therefore committing a crime for theft of power as per section 135 (1) (b) of the Indian Electricity act 2003 amended on 2007. Accordingly the connection was disconnected and the energy meter and service cable were seized and labelled. A copy of both inspection report and Seizure list (1. HPCL Meter, 1 Phase, (240 Volts), (5-30) amps, SI No P1513954, property of WBSEDCL, & 2. Service Cable of Black Color, Single Stranded, Double Core Aluminium wire of 7 meters approx) were handed over to Sri Swapan Barman. As per information collected from site, Sri Swapan Barman who is an electrician by profession had connected the already disconnected line after consent was received from his father Sri Abhay Barman. We exited the premises on 1315hrs.

Thus you are requested to kindly initiate an investigation against Sri. Abhay Barman under Section 135 (1) (b) & against Sri Swapan Barman under Section 150 of the Indian Electricity act 2003 amended on 2007.
