Sir,

In producing here with five arrested accused persons namely 1)Bhola Singh (18) S/o Pokana Singh of Debidanga Bazar, PS-Pradhan Nagar, Dist-Darjeeling 2) Wasing Rahaman (18) S/O Bablu Rahaman of Ananda May Colony Champasari, PS-Pradhan Nagar, Dist-Darjeeling, 3) Avek Chettri (26) s/O Bhabani Chettri of 6 Mile PS-Ranipool Dist East Sikkim,4) Krishna Singh (26) S/o Kishari Singh of Harishchandrar Ppur I.T.I College PS Harishchandrapur Dist-Malda, 5) jay Prakadsh Shah (30) s/o Bacchu Lal Shah of Chapra Bihar PS-Iswardpur Village, Bihar under arrested U/S 41 Cr.P.C and do hereby I PSI Kalyan Saha lodge a written complaint against them.

In this regard I beg to inform you that on 07.01.2021 while performing patrolling van duty received information that some persons were loitering without wearing mask at Champasari More area. I along with C/974 Mintu Sen and C/830 Pradip Roy had been to Champasari More area and found that the above noted persons were gathering and loitering without wearing mask. They violated the order No.-753/XVI-ISS/2M-22/2020 dated 15/05/2021 and Notification number 347 -01.S.S / 2M-24/2020 dated 3rd June, 2020 and Memo No 486-CS/2021 dated 24th April, 2021 Promulgated by Govt. of West Bengal to combat with the spread of Covid-19. Finding no other alternative, along with force apprehended them and arrested them U/S 41C.rPC in between 21.05 hrs to 21.45 hrs. On interrogation, they disclosed their names and address as noted above. On further asking, they admitted that they were aware of the Lockdown Order and restrictions imposed upon the movement of general public and vehicle to combat against the spread of Covid-19.

I, therefore, pray before you that a specific case may kindly be started against above noted arrested accused persons and take lawful action.
