
With due respect, I SI Binup Mahato of Bagdogra PS, do hereby lodge this written complaint against the following arrested persons namely 1) Obaidullah Azmi 22yrs s/o Md Azam of Parsauni PS, Patauna Dist Madhubani Bihar ii) Md Neyaz 19yrs s/o Late Md Anjar of Parsauni PS, Patauna Dist Madhubani Bihar iii) Md Sakid 18yrs s/o Md Gulab of Parsauni PS, Patauna Dist Madhubani Bihar iv) Mobassir Zafar 21yrs s/o Jafar Alam of Parsauni PS, Patauna Dist Madhubani Bihar v) Mohammad Siddique 20yrs s/o Abdus Sami Siddiqui of Parsauni PS, Patauna Dist Madhubani Bihar to violate Government of West Bengal order vide order No. 753/XVII-ISS-22/2020 dated 02.01.2022.

The facts of the case in brief is that today on 10.01.2022 in course special checking duty alongwith force under the supervision of O.C. Bagdogra vide Bagdogra PS, vide GDE No 1082 Dtd, 10.01.2022 at 19-55 hrs the above noted persons were coming towards Ghoshpukur side by a black color four wheeler car styled as Bagdogra side by a four wheeler car styled as Fortuna bearing Registration no DL4CNE/5094 on search the vehicle at Bihar more it was noticed that all passengers with driver gathered on the vehicle also in casual attitude and they all are did not wearing Face mask to violating the restriction measures issued by the Government of West Bengal. I repeatedly cautioned them and warned them to wear Masks but they did not listen rather showed negligent and casual attitude and their unlawful movement found likely to spread COVID -19 dieses which is dangerous to life also high rate of infectivity and multiple cases of a new COVID-19 variant "Omicron", in addition to restriction and relaxation measures as already in force. Finding no other alternative way to save people and restraint the dieses not to spared others the above mentioned persons could be apprehended. On interrogation, they all disclosed their names and address as noted above. On further asked, they all admitted that they all were aware of the order to wear facial Mask in public place. As they had violated the order of State Government of WB vide order No 753/V-ISS/2M-22/2020 Dated 15.12.2021 and earlier orders promulgated to contain the spread of Covid-19 virus. Therefore, they were arrested in between 20-05 hrs to 20-35 hrs and brought to Police Station and put in Police Custody and also seized the vehicle as per proper seizure list and released on zimmanama .

Under the above facts and circumstances, I request you that a specific case against the aforementioned persons may kindly started with suitable sections of law.
