Sir,

With due respect and humble submission I PSI Sumit Sarkar S/o Sri Haripada Sarkar Presently posted at Pradhan Nagar PS, Siliguri Police Commissionerate beg to lodge complaint against 40/50 unknown miscreants to the effect that on 12.01.2022 at 01:35 hrs I along with force chased a speeding motor cycle(Bullet) proceeding from Salbari to Methibari side violating the signal of Methibari Naka, as there was sufficient doubt that unknown miscreants stolen away the same as in the same time of 02.01.2021 night Three(03) such Bullet Motor cycles have been stolen away from the said area and taken the same path for fleeing away .As the motor cycle suddenly took the route of New Chamta the we also followed the same informing the counterpart(PC team) of Matigara PS.The team reached Khaprail Bazar but the said motorcycle could not be traced at that area. During return journey to Pradhan Nagar PS area through the same route the team found a speeding vehicle (Maruti Omni) with 3/4 occupants following the opposite route coming from Salbari side in suspicious manner. Police team tried to stop the vehicle to enquire but seeing police they geared up and proceeded toward Khaprail bazaar. As there was some reliable information in our hand that the miscreants are using such type of vehicle for commission of crime, we again chased the said vehicle and at reasonable distance found that the occupants got down from the vehicle at Putin bari tea garden and the vehicle disappeared. However they could able to detain one of its occupants of young age while the rest occupants fled away into Tea Garden. While coming back from the spot with the detained boy, a group of villagers obstructed the road with boulders inside the garden area and took away the boy from our van. In the mean time PC van of Matigara PS has been informed and they reached after a while. In the mean time another night patrolling van of Matigara PS reached at the spot around 02:30 hrs and all the police teams left the spot along with two vans of Matigara PS. Around 03:05 hrs in front of gate of the Tea garden again a mob of 40/50 persons obstructed them and without saying anything they started assaulting the our police teams with wooden sticks, planting stones, iron rod, sharp cutting weapons etc. As a result following police personnel received injuries on their persons and two vehicles bearing Reg no.WB 77-4723 and Reg. no.WB74 AV 6840 have been damaged by the miscreants. As a result myself along with following police personnel ASI Ashit Singha, C 1413 Sujit Sarkar, C/1415 Chandan Basak, CV 646 Baban Das, CV 242 Rakesh Mangar, CV 128 Ajay Sahani, Suraj Routh (Hired Diver) received severe injury and treated at Siliguri District Hospital.

Hence, I pray before your honour that a necessary legal action may kindly be initiated against the against the miscreants and oblige.
