I, SI Uday Chakraborty of Siliguri PS, SPC do here by lodged a written complaint against above noted arrested accused person namely Sankar Biswas (34 yrs) S/O Late Satyaranjan Biswas of Sarbohara Colony, Ward No. 28,PS-Siliguri, Dist- Darjeeling to the effect that on 16.01.22 at 00.05 hrs acting on secret source information that the above noted person was busy to sale Id liquor illegally at his house situated at Sarbohara Colony, Ward No. 28 under Siliguri PS in order to clandestinely dispose the same.
