Sir,

In producing here with the one accused person namely Peter Sherpa (40) s/o Kamal Bahadur Sherpa of Salugara, Thutay Bazar, Demdema Busty, PS Bhaktinagar, Dist- Jalpaiguri along with following seized articles as per proper seizure list:

1. Twenty Bottles of Himalyan Gold 60 UP Country Spirit each bottle containing 600ml.
2. Three Bottles of Officers Choice Deluxe Whisky each bottle containing 180 ml.
3. Three Bottles of Old Monk matured XXX RUM each containing 180 ml.
4. Three Bottles of Mc. Dowells No 1 Celebration Matured XXX Rum each containing 180 ml.

I, PSI Sailesh Subba of Bhaktinagar PS under Siliguri Police Commissionerate lodged this written complaint against the above noted accused person to the effect that on 19.01.2022 while performing PC mobile van duty vide BKN PS GDE No. 1105, Dt. 19.01.2022 at around 14.55 hrs received a source information from Salugara that the above noted accused person has stored huge amount of Liquor illegally in his Shop named and style as "ROSI STORES" at Thutey Bazaar, Salugara under Bhaktinagar PS for selling the same to the local customers. Accordingly the information share before you and as per your kind direction myself along with ASI Rabin Lama, Constable C/762 Mujibur Rahaman, CVF, 619 Dharmendra Roy headed towards Salugara to verify the veracity of the information. At about 14.55 hrs we reached at Salugara and held raid at the aforesaid shop and apprehend one accused person who disclosed his identity as noted above and searched and recovered above noted seized articles. On enquiry the apprehended person admitted his guilt and stated that he has been storing for the purpose of selling the same to the local customer since long without any valid licence or Documents for his wrongful gain. Accordingly, I prepared seizure list of the above noted articles in presence of witnesses duly sign by the accused as well as witnesses. The seizure made between 15.10 hrs to 15.25 hrs. As he has violated the rules and norms of Bengal Excise Act hence I arrested the apprehended accused person u/s 41 Cr.P.C appraising him the ground of arrest.

I, therefore pray before your kind honour that a specific case may kindly be registered against the accused person namely Peter Sherpa (40) s/o Kamal Bahadur Sherpa of Salugara, Thutay Bazar, Demdema Busty, PS Bhaktinagar, Dist- Jalpaiguri under proper section of law and arrange for its investigation.
