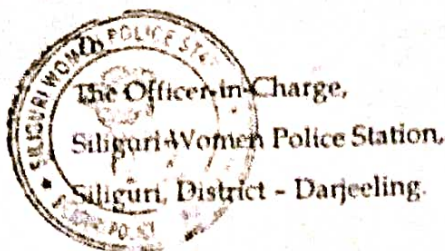

Sub: Written complaint under Section 498A of Indian Penal Code.

Respected Sir/Madam,

I, Smt. Seema Agarwal, W/o Sri Rajesh Agarwal, presently residing at S.F. Road, Near Sushil Pharmacy, Khalpara, Siliguri-734005 do hereby want to state as follows :-


1. That I am legally married wife of Sri Rajesh Agarwal, S/o of Prakash Chand Agarwal and our marriage was solemnized on 15th April, 2000 at Agrasen Bhawan, Khalpara and after our marriage I started to residing at my matrimonial house situated at S.P. Mukherjee Road, Khalpara, Siliguri-734005 with my mother-in-law (Smt. Meena Devi Agarwal), father-in-law (Sri. Prakash Chand Agarwal) and brother-in-law (Sri Manish Agarwal). That out of said wedlock I have a son namely Ayush Agarwal aged about 21 years.
2. That prior to our marriage me and my family were made to believe that my husband is independent & sensible person and has a good going business in Siliguri. Unfortunately soon after our marriage I came to know that my husband neither had any source of income nor any involvement in the family business. He used to stay idle at home and slowly it came to my knowledge that he is a habitual drinker and smoker.
3. That it is pertinent to mention here that my father-in-law and brother-in-law have a good-going family business but they never made an effort to convince my husband to work with them and as such I had no helping hands to bear my financial expenses and it is very tough for me to manage and cope-up with the educational expenses of my son which is very frustrating.
4. That with due course of time my husband rather than realizing his responsibility and doing any job for livelihood used to demand money from me and asked me to bring money from my parental home for him to spend the money over his illicit expenses. And after knowing such facts when I

It is also pertinent to mention here that due to such behavior of my husband not only my son's mental and physical health was deteriorating but because of my husband's habit of sitting idle and my son's education was also getting hampered.

10. That in the year of 2020, when Covid 19 took over the world, my life came to stand still and again my husband used to only drink and smoke and he even started to offer my son to accompany him to drink and when I tried to resist him, he shouted at me and slapped me.
11. That suddenly in the month of March, 2021 my husband left the house but still at times he used to come to my rented house in drunken state and create ruckus and humiliate me and my son in front of my neighbors. It is pertinent to mention here that whenever I tried to deny my husband to enter into my rented house he threatened me of dire consequences if I stopped him from entering into my home.

It is also pertinent to mention here that after the abovementioned incident my in-laws have started torturing me regularly by coming to my rented house at any given point of time by using various means, be it mental, physical or verbal and even my husband keeps calling me hurling abuses at me whenever he wants. And since last 15 days, me and my son are starving even for basic necessities of life, we are left with no food and no money. Whenever I try to do any work for our living, my husband follows me to my workplace and starts abusing me and leaves me with no other option but to leave working. It is to be mentioned here that since my parents are getting aged and my brothers have their own family, I cannot be dependent on them anymore.

In such circumstances, finding no other alternative I come before you with this present complaint and request you to take necessary action in respect of the above matter as per law and to help me to get justice.
