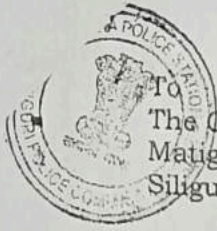

Sir:-

In producing herewith five accused persons namely (1) Arghyajit Maitra (19), S/O-Lt Abhijit Maitra, of-Deshbandhupara, Gopal More, W/No-30, PS-Siliguri, Dist-Darjeeling, (2) Koushik Dey (22), S/O - Sudipta Dey, of - Deshbandhupara, Asha Apartment, Satyen Bose Road, PS-Siliguri, Dist-Darjeeling, (3) Ranjit Barman (18), S/O-Nikhil Barman, of-Vill-Nagarbari, PO-Chanderkuthi, PS-Dinhata, Dist-Cooch Behar, (4) Badal Barman (18), S/O-Bablu Barman, of - Vill Karala, PO-Nayarhat, PS-Dinhata, Dist-Cooch Behar, (5) Abinash Pradhan (30), S/O-Rammohan Pradhan, of-Pelku Jote, PS-Matigara, Dist-Darjeeling arrested u/s-41 Cr.P.C do hereby lodge a written complaint against them.

In this regard I beg to state that on 22.01.2022 at about 15.05 hrs while performing special mobile van duty vide NBMC OP GDE No 858 Dated 22.01.2022, received information that some people are violating the order of restrictions of Govt of West Bengal due to corona virus and some people roaming aimlessly without wearing facial mask at Chathat Medical More. Informed O/C Matigara PS and as per his direction, I along with force had been to Chathat Medical More under NBMC OP and arrested the above noted accused persons. They are completely violating the lockdown measures issued by Chief Secretary West Bengal vide order no 618-ISS/2M-22/2020 Dated 30.04.2021 and 622-ISS/2M-22/2020 Dated 01.05.2021 issued by the Ministry of Health & Family Welfare, Government of India, order no 403/2020-DM-1(A) Dtd. 29.04.2021 and order No 647-ISS/2M-22/2020 Dated 15.05.2021. On seeing police, they tried to flee away but somehow, the above noted persons could be apprehended. On interrogation, they disclosed their name and address as noted above. On further interrogation, they admitted that they were aware of the lockdown order and restriction imposed upon the movement of human being and shops. As they has violated the lockdown order promulgate by the appropriate Government Authority and also the provision of Disaster Management Act, 2005, I with the help of force arrested them u/s-41 Cr.P.C by issuing them memo of arrest.

I, therefore pray that a specific case under proper section of law may kindly be initiated against the above noted arrested accused persons.
